CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Next case is
12-CMP-00736, The Reef located at 2442 18th
Street, N.W., License No. 60475 in ANC 1C.

MS. SCHMIDT: Good morning. Amy
Schmidt, Assistant Attorney General on behalf
of the District of Columbia.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Good morning.

MR. HARRISON: Brian Harrison,
owner/operator of The Reef Restaurant.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Good morning.

MR. HARRISON: Thank you.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Harrison,
did you receive notice of this hearing?

MR. HARRISON: Yes, ma'am.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Did you read
it and understand it?

MR. HARRISON: Yes, ma'am.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Then
we're going to move that notice into the
record, unless you have an objection.

1 MR. HARRISON: Okay. Thank you.

2 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Are
3 there any preliminary matters in this case?

4 MS. SCHMIDT: Yes, there is. We
5 have an Offer in Compromise to today
6 consisting of a \$1,500 fine for the
7 establishment and we have agreed to give them
8 two months, 60 days to pay that.

9 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All right.
10 Mr. Harrison, are you agreeable to the Offer
11 in Compromise that the Assistant Attorney
12 General has described as being a penalty of
13 \$1,500 payable within 60 days?

14 MR. HARRISON: Yes.

15 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: And do you
16 understand that you waive your right to a
17 hearing if you accept in Offer in Compromise?

18 MR. HARRISON: I do.

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Are
20 there any Board questions?

21 (No audible response.)

22 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All right.

1 Then at this point I move that the Board
2 approve the Offer in Compromise of a \$1,500
3 fine payable within 60 days. Do I have a
4 second?

5 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr.
7 Silverstein has seconded the motion. All
8 those in favor, say aye?

9 (Chorus of ayes.)

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
11 opposed?

12 (No audible response.)

13 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Those
14 abstaining?

15 (No audible response.)

16 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: The motion
17 passes by a vote of 4-0-0 to accept the Offer
18 in Compromise.

19 Okay. Thank you. Thank you very
20 much.
