3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Good morning,
4 ladies and gentlemen. I would like to welcome
5 you to the regularly scheduled meeting of the
6 District of Columbia Alcoholic Beverage
7 Control Board. Today is May 8, 2013.

8 My name is Ruthanne Miller. I'm
9 the Chairperson. To my far right is Mr.
10 Donald Brooks, to my immediate right is Mr.
11 Nick Alberti and to my immediate left is Mr.
12 Mike Silverstein, Board Members. The Board
13 has four Members in attendance today for the
14 conduct of business, with three constituting
15 a quorum.

16 Copies of today's hearing calendar
17 and agenda are available at the receptionist
18 desk. Please be aware that these proceedings
19 are being recorded by a court reporter.
20 Accordingly, we must ask you to refrain from
21 any disruptive noises or actions in the
22 hearing room.

1 If you have any electronic
2 devices, pagers, cell phones or such, please,
3 make certain they are turned off to avoid any
4 interruption of the proceedings.

5 Please note when you come to the
6 table in the front have a seat and please
7 sign-in at the paper on the table. This is to
8 ensure the correct spelling of your name for
9 the record.

10 The Open Meetings Act requires
11 that the public hearing on each case be open
12 to the public. The Board may consistent with
13 Section 405(b) of the Open Meetings Act enter
14 a closed meeting during or after the public
15 hearing on a case to consult with an attorney
16 to obtain legal advice, discuss settlement
17 agreements or deliberate upon a decision in an
18 adjudication proceeding.

19 Okay. We will now turn to this
20 morning's calendar. The first case on the
21 calendar is Case No. 12-251-00136, Northeast
22 Supermarket, License No. 81240, located at

1 1201 Mount Olivet Road, N.E.

2 Would the parties, please, come
3 forward? And are you the interpreter? Okay.
4 So could you introduce yourself for the
5 record? I'll swear you in.

6 INTERPRETER KIM: My name is Bona
7 Kim.

8 MEMBER ALBERTI: The microphone is
9 not on. The bar in front, the bar right at
10 the bottom. There is a bar at the bottom.

11 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Just push.

12 MEMBER ALBERTI: There you go.
13 Thank you.

14 INTERPRETER KIM: My name is Bona
15 Kim. I'm here as an interpreter.

16 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. For
17 what language?

18 INTERPRETER KIM: For Korean.

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All Right.
20 If you will raise your right hand, I'll swear
21 you in.

22 Do you solemnly affirm that you

1 will faithfully and accurately interpret the
2 proceedings in this matter from Korean into
3 English and from English into Korean to the
4 best of your ability?

5 INTERPRETER KIM: I do.

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Great.
7 Then your client, could you state your name
8 for the record? Not your client, I'm sorry.
9 The licensee?

10 MS. JUNG: My name is Soon Hee
11 Jung.

12 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: And you are
13 the owner?

14 MS. JUNG: Yes.

15 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. And
16 for the Government?

17 MS. ZANIEL: Good morning, Maureen
18 Zaniel on behalf of the District.

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. And I
20 want to ask Ms. Kim, did she receive notice of
21 this hearing?

22 INTERPRETER KIM: Yes.

1 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: And did she
2 read and understand it?

3 MS. JUNG: I read it, but I
4 haven't understood everything, but I just look
5 to the counsel here today and understood a
6 little bit.

7 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: I'm sorry,
8 she didn't understand everything, but what?

9 INTERPRETER KIM: She read the
10 whole thing, but she didn't under -- she
11 didn't have the full understanding. After
12 speaking to the lawyer today, she under -- she
13 had a better understanding.

14 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: She
15 understands it after speaking to the lawyer
16 for the Government. Okay. And so I'm going
17 to move that notice into the record, unless
18 there is any objection.

22 evidence.)

1 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Are
2 there any preliminary matters?

3 MS. ZANIEL: No. We are not going
