3 BOARD AGENT FLETCHER: Would the
4 parties in the matter of Po Boy Jim please come
5 forward. The parties in the matter of Po Boy Jim.
6 This is Case No. 15-PRO-00025, Rebecca Antoine t/a
7 Po Boy Jim, 709 H Street, N.E., License No. ABRA-
8 087903. This is a Retailer Class CR, Substantial
9 Change (Entertainment Endorsement for Karaoke and
10 a Disc Jockey.)

11 My name is LaVerne Fletcher and I'm
12 conducting the Roll Call Hearing as the Board's
13 Agent pursuant to D.C. Official Code 1601.2. And
14 the protest issues are adverse impact on peace,
15 order and quiet. Introductions beginning with
16 the applicant please.

17 MS. ANTOINE: Yes. Good morning.
18 Rebecca Antoine owner of Po Boy Jim at 709 H
19 Street, N.E.

20 BOARD AGENT FLETCHER: And Ms.
21 Antoine, would you spell your name for the record
22 please?

1 MS. ANTOINE: Sure. R-e-b-e-c-c-a
2 last name Antoine A-n-t-o-i-n-e.

3 BOARD AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you. And
4 present on behalf of ANC 6C?

5 MR. COURTNEY: Yes. My name is Drew
6 Courtney D-r-e-w last name C-o-u-r-t-n-e-y. I'm
7 the Chair of the Alcoholic Beverage Licensing
8 Committee for ANC 6C and I'm the designated
9 representative from the ANC for this matter.

10 BOARD AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you. ANC
11 6C does have standing as a protestant. We need to
12 set a date for a mediation of status hearing and
13 the protest hearing and I'll give you the dates
14 for the status and protest hearing first.

15 The status hearing is set for June 17th
16 at 9:30 a.m. and the protest hearing is set for
17 July 15th at 1:30 p.m., and you'll receive written
18 notice of those dates. Protest hearing is July
19 15th at 1:30.

20 Ms. Antoine, did you put your contact
21 information on that sheet?

22 MS. ANTOINE: Yes ma'am.

1 BOARD AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Thank
2 you. We need to set a date for mediation to
3 occur prior to June 17th and I'll give you some
4 dates that are available. Well, I'll give you
5 the next few dates that are available. The next
6 available date is Thursday May 21st at 9, 10 or
7 11.

8 MR. COURTNEY: I could maybe do 11
9 although another date--

10 BOARD AGENT FLETCHER: We could move
11 to another date.

12 MR. COURTNEY: If we could.

13 BOARD AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. We can
14 do Tuesday, May 26th or Thursday, May 28th at 9,
15 10 or 11.

16 MR. COURTNEY: The 28th would be
17 better.

18 BOARD AGENT FLETCHER: The 28th is
19 good. Is that good for you, Ms. Antoine?

20 MS. ANTOINE: Yes.

21 BOARD AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. So we'll
22 do the 28th at what time? 11?

1 MS. ANTOINE: Can you do 10?

2 MR. COURTNEY: 10 would be good.

3 BOARD AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Then
4 we'll schedule the mediation for 10 o'clock on
5 Thursday, May 28th.

6 MS. ANTOINE: Is it possible that the
7 July 15th date can be changed?

8 BOARD AGENT FLETCHER: July 15th?
9 That is the date of the protest hearing. What you
10 can do you can send an email to Martha Jenkins,
11 she's the general counsel. Her name is Martha
12 Jenkins, her email address is
13 martha.jenkins@dc.gov. And you may request that
14 the protest hearing date be rescheduled and if you
15 will copy Mr. Courtney on that email. If the
16 matter is resolved in mediation then it won't
17 matter but if it's not resolved then you can
18 petition her to change the date.

19 MS. ANTOINE: Okay.

20 BOARD AGENT FLETCHER: The notice you
21 get from me will have a July 15th date and if they
22 change it they'll send you a separate notice.

1 Okay? So then mediation is set for 10 o'clock on
2 May 28th and the mediation takes place here. My
3 card is on the table, I'm the Board's mediator,
4 the mediation will be with me most likely in this
5 room. Okay? So I'll see you then.

6 MR. COURTNEY: Thank you.

7 MS. ANTOINE: Thank you.
