Room, Reeves Building, 2000 14th Street, N.W.,
Suite 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009, Ms. LaVerne
Fletcher, Agent, presiding.

3 AGENT FLETCHER: Would the parties in
4 the matter of O'Connor's Liquors please come
5 forward? This is Case No. 15-PRO-00036,
6 O'Connor's Liquors Incorporated t/a O'Connor's
7 Liquors, 2900 Minnesota Avenue, S.E., License No.
8 ABRA-060231. This is a Retailer Class A License
9 renewal.

10 The protest issues are adverse impact
11 on peace, order and quiet.

12 My name is LaVerne Fletcher. I'm
13 conducting the Roll Call Hearing as the Board's
14 Agent pursuant to D.C. Official Code 1601.2.

15 Introduction beginning with the
16 applicant, please. Your name, sir?

17 MR. AHN: First name is B-Y-O-U-N-G
18 and last name is A-H-N, like in Nancy.

19 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
20 Is that pronounced Mr. Ahn?

21 MR. AHN: Yes.

22 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you. If you

1 would write your contact information on that
2 sign-in sheet? Thank you. And present on behalf
3 of ANC-7B?

4 MS. HOWARD-CHITTAMS: Patricia Howard-
5 Chittams. That is Howard, H-O-W-A-R-D, hyphen
6 Chittams, C-H-I-T-T-A-M-S.

7 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms.
8 Howard-Chittams. And we received the email that
9 you are representing the ANC --

10 MS. HOWARD-CHITTAMS: Yes.

11 AGENT FLETCHER: -- in this matter.
12 That's fine, Mr. Yang, that you help Mr. Ahn. We
13 appreciate it. Thank you.

14 And so, Mr. Ahn, would you like for us
15 to schedule an interpreter for upcoming hearings?

16 MR. AHN: (No audible answer.)

17 AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. I'll do that.

18 MS. HOWARD-CHITTAMS: Yes.

19 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you.

20 MR. AHN: My friend --

21 AGENT FLETCHER: Would that be good?

22 MR. AHN: Yes.

1 INTERPRETER YANG: He has his brother-
2 in-law who can do that.

3 AGENT FLETCHER: Oh, you can have your
4 brother-in-law come?

5 MR. AHN: Yes.

6 AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Because if you
7 want us to, we will also. So you can --

8 MR. AHN: No.

9 AGENT FLETCHER: You're good?

10 MR. AHN: I'm fine. I'm fine.

11 AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you.

12 MS. HOWARD-CHITTAMS: I just wanted to
13 make sure he understands everything.

14 AGENT FLETCHER: No problem. I
15 appreciate it. Thank you.

16 MR. AHN: Okay.

17 AGENT FLETCHER: If you change your
18 mind, let me know.

19 MR. AHN: Okay.

20 AGENT FLETCHER: ANC-7B does have
21 standing as a protestant. We need to set a date
22 for mediation, a Status Hearing and a Protest

1 Hearing. I'll give you the date for the Status
2 and Protest Hearing first.

3 The Status Hearing is scheduled for
4 June 24 at 9:30 a.m. That's June 24 at 9:30.

5 MS. HOWARD-CHITTAMS: June 24, that's
6 fine with me.

7 AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you.
8 That will be at 9:30 on June 24, 9:30.

9 MS. HOWARD-CHITTAMS: Yes.

10 AGENT FLETCHER: That's the Status
11 Hearing before the Board.

12 Okay. And then the Protest hearing is
13 scheduled for July 22nd at 4:30 p.m.

14 MS. HOWARD-CHITTAMS: Beautiful time.

15 AGENT FLETCHER: Hum?

16 MS. HOWARD-CHITTAMS: I said that's a
17 beautiful time.

18 MR. AHN: Is it July 22nd?

19 MS. HOWARD-CHITTAMS: 22nd.

20 MR. AHN: All right.

21 AGENT FLETCHER: July 22nd, yes.

22 MS. HOWARD-CHITTAMS: And that's fine.

1 AGENT FLETCHER: And we need to set a
2 date for mediation to occur prior to June 24.
3 The next available date is June the 12th, that's
4 on a Friday, at 9:00, 10:00 or 11:00.

5 MR. AHN: 9:00, 10:00?

6 AGENT FLETCHER: 9:00, 10:00 or 11:00.

7 MS. HOWARD-CHITTAMS: 9:00 is fine.

8 AGENT FLETCHER: 9:00. Okay. So then
9 mediation is set for Friday, June 12 at 9:00.
10 June 12th.

11 MS. HOWARD-CHITTAMS: June 12, Friday.

12 AGENT FLETCHER: June 12 at 9:00.
13 Okay. Any questions at all?

14 MS. HOWARD-CHITTAMS: Is that that
15 time that we work out the --

16 AGENT FLETCHER: Yes, that's the
17 mediation, yes. That's when you meet with the
18 Board's mediator to try and negotiate a
19 settlement to resolve the protest issues.

20 MS. HOWARD-CHITTAMS: And if we are
21 able to do so beforehand, we merely notify you?

22 AGENT FLETCHER: Right.

1 MS. HOWARD-CHITTAMS: Okay.

2 AGENT FLETCHER: And then you would
3 send in the signed agreement. If you can do that
4 before then, that would be great. You can just
5 send it in.

6 MS. HOWARD-CHITTAMS: Okay.

7 AGENT FLETCHER: And then we would
8 cancel the mediation and if the Board approves
9 the settlement agreement, then we would cancel
10 the Status Hearing and the Protest Hearing.

11 MS. HOWARD-CHITTAMS: Okay.

12 AGENT FLETCHER: So if that happens,
13 just let me know.

14 MS. HOWARD-CHITTAMS: Okay.

15 AGENT FLETCHER: And my card is on the
16 table.

17 MS. HOWARD-CHITTAMS: Yes, I know.
18 Right, okay. Thank you.

19 AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Well, then
20 thank you very much.

21 MS. HOWARD-CHITTAMS: All right.
22 Thank you.

1 AGENT FLETCHER: See you in mediation
2 or not if you work it out.

3 MS. HOWARD-CHITTAMS: Okay. Have a
4 good day.

5 AGENT FLETCHER: Okay.

6 MR. AHN: Do I need to fill out this
7 form?

8 AGENT FLETCHER: Yes. If you -- Mr.
9 Ahn, if you go to contact -- your contact
10 information on that sheet, your daytime phone
11 number and your email address. Thank you. Thank
12 you very much.
