4 in the matter of Matchbox case come forward.

5 This is Case No. 13-PRO-00058,  
6 Matchbox Capitol Hill, LLC, trading as  
7 Matchbox, 521 8th Street, S.E., License No.  
8 ABRA-079276. This is a Retailer CR License  
9 Renewal.

10 The protest issues are adverse  
11 impact on peace, order and quiet.

12 My name is La Verne Fletcher.  
13 I'll be conducting the Roll Call Hearing as  
14 the Board's Agent, pursuant to D.C. Official  
15 Code 1601.2.

16 Introductions, beginning with the  
17 applicant, please.

18 MR. FONSECA: Michael Fonseca, on  
19 behalf of the licensee. With me is --

20 MR. HERRMANN: Fred Herrmann.

21 MR. FONSECA: -- Fred -- the vice  
22 president. Vice president.

1 MS. FLETCHER: And what's the  
2 first --

3 MR. FONSECA: I didn't remember  
4 his position and his name. I was like uh-oh.

5 MS. FLETCHER: And what's the  
6 first name again?

7 MR. HERRMANN: Fred.

8 MR. FONSECA: Fred.

9 MS. FLETCHER: Fred. Okay.

10 MR. FONSECA: Herrmann, double  
11 "n."

12 MR. HERRMANN: Double "r's," too.

13 MR. FONSECA: Double "r's," too.

14 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. H-e-r-r- --  
15 did you say double --

16 MR. HERRMANN: Double "r's" and  
17 double "n's."

18 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.

19 And, Mr. Fonseca, would you spell  
20 your name for the court reporter.

21 MR. FONSECA: Yes. F-o-n-s-e-c-a.

22 MS. FLETCHER: And present on

1       behalf of ANC6B.

2                   MS. ROLE: Hello. My name is  
3       Susan Eads Role. That's S-u-s-a-n, E-a-d-s,  
4       R-o-l-e. And I am here on behalf of ANC6B.

5                   MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very  
6       much. And ANC6B does have standing as a  
7       protestant. I need to give you dates for  
8       mediation, a status hearing and a protest  
9       hearing, and I'll give you the dates for the  
10      status hearing and the protest hearing first.

11                   The date for the status hearing is  
12      July the 24th. July 24 at 9:30 a.m. The date  
13      for the protest hearing is September the 25th,  
14      2013 at 1:30 p.m.

15                   And we need to set a date for the  
16      mediation to occur prior to July 24. There  
17      are a couple of dates available in June.  
18      Those are Tuesday, June 25 and Thursday, June  
19      27, if those work for anyone.

20                   That's -- the 25th is a Tuesday,  
21      and the 27th is a Thursday.

22                   MR. FONSECA: Thursday.

1 MR. HERRMANN: Thursday.

2 MR. FONSECA: How about the  
3 Thursday.

4 MS. FLETCHER: Is Thursday good?  
5 So, that's June 27th. Let's see. Okay. Ten,  
6 eleven, one. Those are the times available.

7 MR. FONSECA: That works.

8 MR. HERRMANN: Ten works.

9 MR. FONSECA: Ten o'clock.

10 MS. FLETCHER: Ten o'clock. So,  
11 mediation is set for June 27 at ten.

12 Thank you for coming.

13 MS. ROLE: Thank you.

14 MS. FLETCHER: The Roll Call  
15 Hearing is concluded.

16 MR. FONSECA: Thank you.

17 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.

18 MR. HERRMANN: Is that it?

19 (Whereupon, the Roll Call hearing
