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The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board met in Alcoholic Beverage Control Hearing Room, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S Washington, D.C., Ms. La Verne Fletcher, Agent, presiding.

AGENT FLETCHER: Would the parties present in the matter of Strand Liquor please come forward? The parties in the matter of Strand Liquors. Thank you. This is Case Number 12-PRO-00051, Sun Ok Kim, trading as Strand Liquor, 605 Division Avenue NE, License Number ABRA-009272 This a Retailer Class A, Renewal Application. The protest issues are adverse impact on peace, order, and quiet and pedestrian safety.

My name is La Verne Fletcher, and I will be conducting the Roll Call Hearing as the Board's Agent pursuant to D.C. Official Code 1601.2.

Introductions, beginning with the Licensee, please?

MS. KIM: My name is Sun Ok Kim, Strand Liquors Store owner.

AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you. And would you spell your name for the record,

1 please?

2 MS. KIM: First name is S-U-N.
3 Middle name is O-K. Last name is K-I-M as in
4 Mary.

5 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you, very
6 much. And Ms. Kim, you are the owner?

7 MS. KIM: Yes.

8 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you, very
9 much. And present for the ANC?

10 MS. BROWN: Sylvia C. Brown.

11 AGENT FLETCHER: And Ms. Brown,
12 would you spell your name for the record?

13 MS. BROWN: S-Y-L-V-A C.
14 B-R-O-W-N.

15 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you.
16 ANC-7C is the only Protestant in this matter
17 and does have standing as a Protestant. We
18 need to set a date for mediation. The next
19 available date for mediation is Tuesday, July
20 24th, if that's a good time for you, Ms. Kim
21 and Ms. Brown.

22 MS. KIM: Okay. I'll take

1 Tuesday. Yes.

2 AGENT FLETCHER: I'm sorry.

3 MS. KIM: It's fine with me.

4 AGENT FLETCHER: Is that good for
5 you?

6 MS. KIM: Yes.

7 AGENT FLETCHER: Ms. Brown, will
8 that work for you, the 24th?

9 MS. BROWN: Sure.

10 AGENT FLETCHER: Any particular
11 time? It could be 9:00, 10:00.

12 MS. KIM: Yes. I'll take the
13 9:00. Is that okay?

14 AGENT FLETCHER: Is 9:00 good for
15 you, Ms. Brown?

16 MS. BROWN: Preferably, mid-
17 morning or late morning.

18 AGENT FLETCHER: Would 11:00 work
19 for you, Ms. Kim?

20 MS. KIM: 11:00 is kind of late.
21 Right now, I'm closing my business, so I would
22 just not want to do it over again.

1 AGENT FLETCHER: So can we do
2 9:00 Ms. Brown?

3 MS. BROWN: I hope that we can go
4 through a voluntary process. But yes, 9:00 is
5 kind of rough for community members to try to
6 make it out for that.

7 AGENT FLETCHER: Well, for the
8 purpose of the mediation --

9 MS. BROWN: Well yes, I know about
10 the mediation process.

11 AGENT FLETCHER: Yes. Exactly.
12 Would 9:30 be better?

13 MS. BROWN: Yes. I guess we can
14 try to work for 9:30.

15 AGENT FLETCHER: Ms. Kim, would
16 9:30 work for you?

17 MS. KIM: That's fine. Yes.

18 AGENT FLETCHER: So then the
19 mediation is set for Tuesday, July 24, at 9:30
20 for Strand Liquors. Ms. Kim, did you write
21 your daytime phone number and e-mail address
22 on that sheet for me?

1 MS. KIM: Yes, I did.

2 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you, very
3 much. Okay. If there are no questions, the
4 Strand Liquors Roll Call Hearing is concluded.
5 Thank you, Ms. Kim, for coming.

6 MS. KIM: Oh, please.

7 AGENT FLETCHER: Do you have a
8 question?

9 MS. KIM: Is it going to be the
10 same place, here?

11 AGENT FLETCHER: Yes.

12 MS. KIM: Yes? Okay.

13 AGENT FLETCHER: Same place. Just
14 check in with the receptionist.

15 MS. KIM: Okay. Thank you, very
16 much.

17 AGENT FLETCHER: You are welcome.
18 And Ms. Kim, I don't see any more of my cards
19 on that table, but you can -- my name is La
20 Verne Fletcher. I can spell that for you if
21 you'd like. It's L-A V-E-R-N-E, and the last
22 name is Fletcher, F-L-E-T-C-H-E-R. And I will

1 give you my phone number. It's (202) 442-
2 4499. In the event you need to contact me
3 before the mediation or for any reason, that's
4 where you can reach me.

5 MS. KIM: So we could talk to each
6 other in between the time to make an
7 agreement?

8 AGENT FLETCHER: Yes. That would
9 be the ideal situation, is to talk before the
10 date of the mediation and, if you can resolve
11 the protest issues before then, that would be
12 great.

13 MS. KIM: Okay.

14 AGENT FLETCHER: And then you can
15 just let us know and we can cancel the
16 mediation and there won't be a Status Hearing
17 or a Protest Hearing. That is the ideal
18 situation.

19 MS. KIM: Okay. Thank you.

20 AGENT FLETCHER: And you can just
21 let us know.

22 MS. KIM: Yes. That's fine.

1 Thank you, very much.

2 AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. And Ms.
3 Brown, if there is a voluntary agreement, can
4 you e-mail it to me?

5 MS. BROWN: Sure.

6 AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you.
7 The Strand Liquor Roll Call Hearing is
8 concluded.
