3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: We have another  
4 Fact-Finding Hearing for a pub crawl. The  
5 applicant is Paige Mosberg.

6 MR. CHUNG: May I be excused?

7 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Yes. Just wait,  
8 wait for your application.

9 For DC United? Okay. Good morning.  
10 Could you just identify yourself for the record?

11 MS. MOSBERG: Yes. My name is Paige  
12 Mosberg.

13 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: And what's your  
14 position?

15 MS. MOSBERG: I'm Account Executive at  
16 DC United.

17 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Great.  
18 All right. So it looks like you are having an  
19 event estimating 600 people for a pub crawl at  
20 multiple locations? No?

21 MS. MOSBERG: Maxing out at 600.

22 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Maxing out at

1 600, right.

2 MS. MOSBERG: I said 200.

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Oh, I see  
4 anticipated number 250 to 500.

5 MS. MOSBERG: Yes.

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Good. Oh,  
7 Mr. Ghenene, do you want to put your name on the  
8 record, too?

9 INVESTIGATOR GHENENE: Yes, ma'am.  
10 Investigator Ghenene with ABRA.

11 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. So this  
12 looks like a relatively small event.

13 MS. MOSBERG: Tiny.

14 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: And it looks like  
15 a fun event.

16 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: In what way,  
17 Madam Chair?

18 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: In the number.

19 MEMBER SHORT: There are a lot of  
20 people.

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: It's going all  
22 over these neighborhoods, it's a small event in

1 numbers. It doesn't sound that big to me.

2 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Not in geography  
3 though.

4 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: No. Okay. So  
5 that's why you are here. I think it's the  
6 geography. You are going to different  
7 neighborhoods.

8 Have you checked out the  
9 establishments with ABRA to make sure that they  
10 all can participate in this?

11 MS. MOSBERG: I submitted the  
12 application and was told that I would be notified  
13 if they were not.

14 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. You will  
15 be. I'm sure, Mr. Ghenene, right, will notify  
16 you. I see you have listed them all on your  
17 application.

18 MS. MOSBERG: Yes.

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. And the  
20 times are 12:00 to 3:00?

21 MS. MOSBERG: 12:00 to 3:00.

22 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. But this

1 is -- is this a new event?

2 MS. MOSBERG: Yes.

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. That's  
4 another reason you are here, because it's new.

5 MS. MOSBERG: Okay.

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All right. Board  
7 Members, questions?

8 MEMBER SHORT: Yes. Geographically  
9 I'm seeing several -- this is spread out all over  
10 three or four different wards?

11 MS. MOSBERG: Yes, sir.

12 MEMBER SHORT: How is it coordinated?

13 MS. MOSBERG: Excuse me?

14 MEMBER SHORT: How is it coordinated?

15 MS. MOSBERG: They are mostly our bar  
16 partners or past bar partners with DC United.  
17 Just trying to keep it along the Metrolines prior  
18 to one of our matches. So it's kind of just  
19 coordinating the hours of the specials. Nothing  
20 is going to be like --

21 MEMBER SHORT: Okay.

22 MS. MOSBERG: -- you know.

1                   MEMBER SHORT: First time I've seen  
2 one of these, so that's the reason why I had the  
3 questions.

4                   CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Others?

5                   MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Sure. What are  
6 the head-waits on Metro on Sunday?

7                   MS. MOSBERG: Excuse me?

8                   MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: What are the  
9 head-waits on Metro on Sunday?

10                  MS. MOSBERG: Well, I'm -- what do you  
11 mean by that?

12                  MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: You should know.  
13 What are the times between trains?

14                  MS. MOSBERG: Oh, they -- it depends.  
15 Usually 15, 20 minutes between on the same line.

16                  MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: So to get from --  
17 if you have to transfer from the Blue line to the  
18 Red line or something, it would be 40 minutes to  
19 get from one bar to another --

20                  MS. MOSBERG: Right.

21                  MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: -- perhaps?

22                  MS. MOSBERG: It's not -- right. And

1 I think the confusion is that it's not really  
2 being, I guess, advertised as a bar crawl. More  
3 that these bars will have specials prior to our  
4 match. So that if you purchase through this  
5 link, you would have access to the specials if  
6 you are 21 and over.

7 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: So this is not  
8 necessarily -- so this is where I was having  
9 serious problems with this.

10 MS. MOSBERG: Go ahead.

11 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: The idea of  
12 people going halfway across --

13 MS. MOSBERG: I know.

14 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: -- town to go  
15 from one bar to another.

16 MS. MOSBERG: No, no, no.

17 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: It -- you know,  
18 and it's listed as a pub crawl.

19 MS. MOSBERG: Okay. My understanding  
20 was --

21 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: I really, really  
22 don't understand. You know, pub crawls are to be

1 in a very limited area where you can generally  
2 walk or crawl.

3 MS. MOSBERG: Right. My under --

4 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: So to speak.

5 MS. MOSBERG: I wanted to submit the  
6 application because there will be coordinated  
7 specials and I think that walking distance is  
8 subjective. So I just was trying to cover  
9 things. We don't want people to go from every  
10 bar. We are keeping the times limited. It's  
11 more of these bars will have specials. Our match  
12 doesn't start until 5:00, so it gives them plenty  
13 of time to get to us.

14 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Okay. There is  
15 a match that day that starts at what time?

16 MS. MOSBERG: 5:00.

17 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: And these events  
18 take place from?

19 MS. MOSBERG: 12:00 to 3:00.

20 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: So basically what  
21 you are saying is that most people are going to  
22 go to one place or maybe two.

1 MS. MOSBERG: Two, yes.

2 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: That's a whole  
3 lot different than what we were -- from what we  
4 had seen.

5 MS. MOSBERG: Yes. It's not --

6 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Or what we had  
7 envisioned.

8 MS. MOSBERG: Yes, it's not a true pub  
9 crawl. It's more of a -- I just didn't want to--

10 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: It's a pre-match  
11 party citywide.

12 MS. MOSBERG: Huh?

13 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: So you are having  
14 a pre-match party citywide?

15 MS. MOSBERG: Yes.

16 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: I feel better  
17 now.

18 MS. MOSBERG: Yes.

19 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: Yes.

20 MS. MOSBERG: No, I definitely don't  
21 want people going from one end to the other.

22 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Have you

1 contacted the other police commanders from the  
2 other Districts? I mean --

3 MS. MOSBERG: 2nd and 3rd.

4 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Oh, you have  
5 talked to Commander Gresham and Commander  
6 Kishter?

7 MS. MOSBERG: Yes.

8 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Are there any  
9 other Districts involved here?

10 MS. MOSBERG: Yes, you've got the one  
11 on --

12 MS. MOSBERG: Not that I'm aware of.  
13 I was -- sent the people to reach out to and I  
14 sent them.

15 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: I would ask you  
16 to double check that and to reach out to the  
17 other affected commanders simply so that one hand  
18 knows what the other is doing.

19 MS. MOSBERG: Okay.

20 MEMBER ALBERTI: There is District 1.

21 MEMBER SHORT: Right. That's the one  
22 there at the Rose, the --

1 MEMBER ALBERTI: Well, District 1 is  
2 southeast here.

3 MEMBER SHORT: Okay. Yes.

4 MEMBER ALBERTI: I don't know if you  
5 have reached out to --

6 MS. MOSBERG: No, just 2 and 3.

7 MEMBER ALBERTI: Okay. So you --

8 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: So Molly Malone's  
9 and Ugly Mug.

10 MEMBER ALBERTI: Yes, that's District  
11 1.

12 MS. MOSBERG: Okay.

13 MEMBER SHORT: The 1st District, yes.

14 MEMBER ALBERTI: Yes. Ms. Jenkins  
15 just said that she will help you coordinate that.

16 MS. MOSBERG: Fine.

17 MEMBER ALBERTI: Give you the  
18 information. Okay.

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Any other Board  
20 Members have questions, comments?

21 MEMBER ALBERTI: Yes. So is there a  
22 cost for this?

1 MS. MOSBERG: Is there a what?

2 MEMBER ALBERTI: A cost for the --

3 MS. MOSBERG: The bars?

4 MEMBER ALBERTI: Yes.

5 MS. MOSBERG: Well --

6 MEMBER ALBERTI: I mean, for the "pub  
7 crawl."

8 MS. MOSBERG: Buying a ticket to the  
9 match.

10 MEMBER ALBERTI: Okay. So now I  
11 understand what the deal is. All right. You buy  
12 a ticket for the match through this link and then  
13 you get access to these specials.

14 MS. MOSBERG: Yes, right.

15 MEMBER ALBERTI: That's what is going  
16 on?

17 MS. MOSBERG: Yes.

18 MEMBER ALBERTI: Great. Thank you for  
19 actually taking this stuff -- this application  
20 out. I appreciate that. Thank you.

21 MEMBER SHORT: Just to make things a  
22 little clearer.

1 MS. MOSBERG: Yes.

2 MEMBER SHORT: If you have a soccer  
3 ticket and you go to one of the bars --

4 MS. MOSBERG: Right.

5 MEMBER SHORT: -- then you --

6 MS. MOSBERG: But it's only -- you  
7 only -- only if you purchase through a certain  
8 link, so that we can track the numbers, because I  
9 don't want to overwhelm any of the bars.

10 MEMBER ALBERTI: Right.

11 MS. MOSBERG: That was what we were  
12 looking for.

13 MEMBER SHORT: Coordination is --  
14 that's your responsibility?

15 MS. MOSBERG: Yes.

16 MEMBER SHORT: Okay. Thank you.  
17 That's all I have, Madam Chair.

18 MEMBER ALBERTI: Thank you.

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: But you have  
20 registration, right?

21 MS. MOSBERG: What do you mean?

22 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Well, I'm looking

1 at the application and it says registration. Do  
2 they have to go to Penn Social or --

3 MS. MOSBERG: Yes. So --

4 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: -- to register?

5 MS. MOSBERG: -- well, that's the way  
6 that -- there is no other way for us to really --  
7 unless I mail everybody out a wristband, which is  
8 fine, but I want the bars to be able to know that  
9 they still have to check the IDs.

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Yes.

11 MS. MOSBERG: Using the wristband is  
12 not --

13 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. That's how  
14 you know everybody is 21, right.

15 MS. MOSBERG: Yes.

16 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Good. Okay.  
17 Others? Mr. Ghenene, do you have any concerns?

18 INVESTIGATOR GHENENE: I'm good.

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

20 MS. MOSBERG: Sorry for the confusion.

21 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: Keep the team in  
22 town.

1 MS. MOSBERG: Please, I don't want to  
2 move.

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

4 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Do you think they  
5 might score the first goal in a game for a  
6 change?

7 MS. MOSBERG: I don't want us to. We  
8 will lose.

9 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Oh, okay.

10 MS. MOSBERG: Only when --

11 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: 5 of the last 10  
12 victories, the other team has scored first?

13 MS. MOSBERG: Yes, in the first like  
14 10 minutes.

15 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: That's crazy.

16 MS. MOSBERG: I was so nervous.

17 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: You are so good  
18 you can spot them a goal, huh?

19 MS. MOSBERG: I'll take that.

20 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All right. I'm  
21 going to move that we approve this application.  
22 Do I have a second?

1 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: Second.

2 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Mr.

4 Silverstein seconded the motion.

5 All those in favor say aye.

6 ALL: Aye.

7 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those

8 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion

9 passes 6-0-0.

10 We are signing off on it. And you

11 will be all set, yes.

12 MS. MOSBERG: Okay.

13 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: I guess Ms.

14 Jenkins is going to coordinate with you about the

15 MPD.

16 MS. MOSBERG: All right.

17 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Good.

18 Thank you very much. Have a great event.
