3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: How about, let's
4 see if we can get a full case here, Case No. 15-
5 PRO-00044, Minnesota Liquors?

6 MEMBER ALBERTI: You skipped over a
7 case?

8 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Yes, it's in a
9 different --

10 MEMBER ALBERTI: Well, you'll come
11 back to it.

12 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Yes.

13 MEMBER ALBERTI: I was just wondering
14 why you skipped over it.

15 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: It's different in
16 my sheet. My two sheets are different. It looks
17 like we may have everybody here though, let's
18 see.

19 Minnesota Liquors, okay, located at
20 2237 Minnesota Avenue, S.E., License No. 222, in
21 ANC-8A. And this is an application to renew the
22 license.

1 And could you identify yourselves for
2 the record?

3 MS. SIMMS: I'm Cynthia Simms from
4 ANC-8A and representing the Single Member
5 District.

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: You're
7 representing the Single Member District, not the
8 ANC?

9 MS. SIMMS: The ANC.

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: You're
11 representing the ANC?

12 MS. SIMMS: Yes, the ANC.

13 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Yes,
14 that's right. Okay. Good. And over here? Are
15 you the applicants?

16 MS. CHUNG: Yes. I'm the daughter,
17 Jennifer Chung.

18 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

19 MS. CHUNG: And my dad, Hae Chung.

20 MR. CHUNG: Hae Chung.

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Good. All
22 right. So this is what is called a status

1 conference, so if there is anything you need to
2 tell us, if you have any concerns about the
3 process, you can ask, otherwise, I'm going to
4 tell you a few things about going to the Protest
5 Hearing. Yes?

6 MS. SIMMS: We have voted not to
7 continue the protest. We are going to withdraw
8 our protest.

9 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

10 MS. SIMMS: And I don't have a letter
11 yet, because the decision was made last night, so
12 I have to get a letter to submit to you all.

13 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All right.
14 That's okay. Then I'm going to be very brief,
15 but just in case something happens and the letter
16 doesn't come in and you end up going to a Protest
17 Hearing, I just want to make sure that you know
18 that you would be getting Protest Information
19 Forms and Exhibit Forms and you have to pay very
20 close attention to them.

21 If you get them and you go to hearing,
22 you need to fill them out and serve them on both

1 sides and on the Board. And they will ask you to
2 identify witnesses and issues and also identify
3 exhibits and attach exhibits.

4 So if you got to the hearing and you
5 didn't do those things, you would be at risk of
6 having your witness be excluded or your exhibit
7 being excluded. Not necessarily, but there would
8 be a good chance if it was a surprise to the
9 other side and they didn't have time to prepare
10 it, because that's what those forms are for, so
11 that everybody knows what to expect at the
12 hearing and everyone is prepared.

13 But anyway, it sounds like you are not
14 going, so that's fine. Anything else? Okay.
15 Well, thank you very much.

16 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Thank you.

17 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: We will look for
18 that letter.

19 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Thank you for
20 coming, Ms. Simms, and thank you all. Thank you
21 for your service.

22 MS. SIMMS: Okay.

1 MS. CHUNG: Thank you.

2 MR. CHUNG: Thank you.

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. That's it.

4 Thank you.

5 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Ms. Simms has a
6 question.

7 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Oh, you have a
8 question?

9 MS. SIMMS: No. I think I have one
10 more. I was just --

11 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Oh, okay.
