CHAIRPERSON MILLER: The next case on our calendar is Case Number 13-CMP-00169, Rumba Caf, located at 2443 18th Street, N.W., License 71023 in ANC 1C.

MS. SCHMIDT: Good morning. Amy Schmidt, Assistant Attorney General on behalf of the District of Columbia standing in for Maureen Zaniel.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

MR. HUAPALLA: Good morning. My name is Angel Huapalla. I'm the chief owner of Rumba Caf,.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. And this is also a show cause status hearing and I want to ask if you received notice of this hearing.

MR. HUAPALLA: Yes.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: And did you read it an understand it?

MR. HUAPALLA: Yes.

1 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Then
2 I'm going to make it a part of the record
3 unless you have any objection.

4 MR. HUAPALLA: Yes, please.

5 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Are
6 there any preliminary matters in this case?

7 MS. SCHMIDT: Yes, there's an
8 offer in compromise and it does entail -- we'd
9 like to amend charge 1 to be a violation of
10 723 instead of B to be in violation of 25.723D
11 as in David and there be a fine of \$500 for
12 that charge which is violation of daylight
13 savings time and the fine for the second
14 charge, charge 2, would be \$1,000 for a total
15 of \$1500.

16 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: To be
17 payable?

18 MS. SCHMIDT: To be payable 30 --
19 30 days?

20 MR. HUAPALLA: Thirty days.

21 MS. SCHMIDT: Thirty days.

22 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All right. I

1 want to confirm with the Licensee that you
2 agree to this offer in compromise of \$1500,
3 \$500 for the first offense and \$1,000 for the
4 second totalling \$1500.

5 MR. HUAPALLA: Yes, I agree.

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: And to be
7 paid within 30 days.

8 MR. HUAPALLA: Yes.

9 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: And you
10 understand you waive your right to a hearing
11 by entering into this offer in compromise?

12 MR. HUAPALLA: Yes.

13 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Then
14 are there any questions by Board Members?

15 Not hearing any, I would move that
16 we accept this offer in compromise of \$1500 to
17 be paid within 30 days for the two charges.
18 So, a total \$1500.

19 Do I have a second?

20 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr.

22 Silverstein seconded the motion.
