3 MS. FLETCHER: Would the parties
4 in the matter of Hill Country Stand please
5 come forward? The parties in the matter of
6 Hill Country Stand?

7 This is Case #13-PRO-00105, Hill
8 Country DC, LLC, trading as Hill Country
9 Stand, 101 Tingey Street, SE, License #ABRA-
10 092452. This is a Retailer CT New
11 Application. The protest issues are adverse
12 impact on peace, order and quiet.

13 My name is LaVerne Fletcher, and
14 I'll be conducting the Roll Call Hearing as
15 the Board's Agent pursuant to DC Official Code
16 1601.2.

17 Introductions beginning with the
18 Applicant?

19 MR. FONSECA: Michael Fonseca on
20 behalf of the Licensee.

21 MEMBER BROOKS: Marc Glosserman
22 from Hill Country Hospitality. I'm the

1 Licensee.

2 MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Glosserman,
3 would you spell your name for the court
4 reporter?

5 MEMBER BROOKS: Yes. M-A-R-C
6 Glosserman -- G-L-O-S-S-E-R-M-A-N.

7 MS. FLETCHER: Glosserman. Okay.

8 MR. FONSECA: Do you need mine?

9 MS. FLETCHER: Yes.

10 MR. FONSECA: Michael,
11 traditional, Fonseca -- F-O-N-S-E-C-A.

12 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. And on
13 behalf of ANC 6D?

14 MR. McBEE: Yes. Hi. My name is
15 Ron McBee. That's M-C, capital B as in boy,
16 E-E.

17 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr.
18 McBee.

19 ANC 6D does have standing as a
20 protestant.

21 We need to set a date for
22 mediation, a status hearing and a protest

1 hearing. And I'll give you the dates for the
2 status and protest hearings first.

3 The status hearing is set for
4 October 2nd at 9:30 a.m.

5 And the protest hearing is set for
6 October 23rd at 1:30.

7 We need to set a date for
8 mediation to occur prior to October 2nd. And
9 I'll give you some dates that are available.

10 Tuesday, September 24 is available
11 at 9:00, 10:00, 11:00 or 1:00. That's
12 Tuesday, September 24.

13 MR. McBEE: How about the 24th at
14 10:00?

15 MS. FLETCHER: Is that good?

16 MR. FONSECA: My partner, Mr.
17 O'Brien, wants to be involved in mediation.

18 MS. FLETCHER: Okay.

19 MR. FONSECA: I know that normally
20 the 10:00 o'clocks are real bad.

21 MS. FLETCHER: Later is better for
22 Mr. O'Brien, right?

1 MR. FONSECA: Yes.

2 MS. FLETCHER: Would 1:00 o'clock
3 work?

4 MR. McBEE: That works fine.

5 MS. FLETCHER: Is it okay, Mr.
6 Fonseca? We can do the 24th at 1:00.

7 MR. FONSECA: 1:00 p.m. works for
8 us.

9 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. So the
10 mediation is set for 1:00 o'clock on September
11 the 24th.

12 Okay. Mr. McBee, I see you're
13 filling out the contact information sheet.
14 Thank you.

15 Okay. And thank you very much.
16 The Roll Call Hearing is concluded.

17 MR. McBEE: Thank you.

18 MR. FONSECA: Thank you.
