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3 MS. MILLER: Okay. Our next show cause
4 hearing status case is Case No. 15-CMP-00272,
5 Lucky 7 Liquors, located at 2314 Rhode Island
6 Avenue Northwest, License No. 90270 in ANC 5C.

7 Do you need a minute or?

8 MR. ADAMS: Oh, sorry. Pardon me, Madam
9 Chair.

10 MS. MILLER: Okay.

11 MR. ROBINSON: Madam Chairman, was that
12 2314 Rhode Island Avenue?

13 MS. MILLER: Yes. Lucky 7.

14 MR. ROBINSON: Yes, Your Honor.

15 MS. MILLER: It's actually scheduled for
16 9:30.

17 MR. ROBINSON: Yes, Your Honor.

18 MR. ADAMS: Parties. Sorry. Walter
19 Adams representing the District of Columbia.

20 MR. ROBINSON: Wendell Robinson
21 representing Lucky 7.

22 Madam Chairman, I asked my client to be

1 here at 11:00, but I had spoken to Ms. Phyllis
2 about the penalties and I submitted an offer and
3 compromise for that, but she won't be in the
4 office until tomorrow. I just spoke to counsel
5 here about it.

6 So what I would ask the Board to do is to
7 give us a short continuance for about a week so
8 that we can resolve. My client is inclined to
9 resolve this with an offer and compromise. The
10 question now is that our counter offer has just
11 now been rejected.

12 MS. MILLER: Okay. So we don't want to
13 get into the negotiations. However you can come
14 back at -- though we don't have -- next week is a
15 holiday.

16 MR. ADAMS: That's right. Next week.

17 MS. MILLER: So that would be two weeks.

18 MR. ADAMS: Right.

19 MS. MILLER: For another status if you
20 have an O and C.

21 MR. ADAMS: The District will volunteer
22 to --

1 MS. MILLER: But we can set a date for
2 the --

3 MR. ADAMS: Sure.

4 MS. MILLER: We can set a date today, and
5 if you want to get on the calendar in two weeks
6 we can schedule you for that, a status as well.

7 MR. ALBERTI: Well, Ms. Miller.

8 MS. MILLER: Yeah.

9 MR. ALBERTI: May I suggest that -- we
10 have a show cause date set, so --

11 MS. MILLER: Right.

12 MR. ALBERTI: -- if there was an offer
13 and compromise made at that point, I mean, we
14 have that date open. We could just do it then
15 rather than try to shoehorn it in. I mean,
16 there's only a few weeks until then, so.

17 MR. ADAMS: Well, I think, Your Honor --
18 I mean, Mr. Alberti, according to my notes the
19 show cause is scheduled for today, so --

20 MR. ALBERTI: We have a status hearing.
21 This is a status hearing.

22 MR. ADAMS: Well, originally, I guess at

1 some point prior to discussion for today. I'm
2 not sure if we have another show cause date.

3 MR. ALBERTI: My notes show a cause --

4 MR. ADAMS: I don't have anything that
5 has that.

6 MR. ALBERTI: My notes show a show cause
7 date of December 9th.

8 MR. ADAMS: December 9th. Thank you.

9 MR. ALBERTI: So that was my suggestion
10 is that --

11 MR. ADAMS: Sure.

12 MR. ALBERTI: -- I mean, certainly if you
13 want to talk to our general counsel and schedule
14 a date before then, that's fine. But we have
15 this date open on December 9th.

16 MR. ADAMS: Yes.

17 MR. ROBINSON: I think the general
18 counsel informed me when I was here last that if
19 we resolve it I could come in on any Wednesday.

20 MS. MILLER: That's been the practice,
21 Mr. Gruden (phonetic). Yeah, so --

22 MR. ROBINSON: And I would hope to do

1 that.

2 MS. MILLER: It doesn't take very much
3 time. If you've resolved it, it takes 3 minutes
4 to come in and, you know, give it to us.

5 MR. ROBINSON: So may I just recommend
6 that we keep the December 9 date and I suspect
7 that I will be able to resolve this and come in
8 earlier, and you can take it off the calendar.
9 Fairly confident it's going to be resolved.

10 MS. MILLER: Okay. So I think that would
11 be the 18th, status.

12 MR. ADAMS: Yes.

13 MR. ROBINSON: Yes, the 18th is fine with
14 me. But what time would that be?

15 MS. MILLER: This is 9:30. All statuses
16 are at 9:30.

17 MR. ROBINSON: That would be fine.

18 MS. MILLER: So, okay.

19 MR. ROBINSON: Thank you very much.

20 MS. MILLER: All right. And it says,
21 status, you're coming November 18th, but
22 meanwhile a show cause is still scheduled for

1 December 9th.

2 MR. ROBINSON: Right. And the 11th is --

3 MS. MILLER: At 10:00.

4 MR. ROBINSON: -- a holiday so I can't
5 come in next Wednesday.

6 MS. MILLER: That's correct. Yes. The
7 doors will probably be locked. We won't be here,
8 I know that.

9 MR. ROBINSON: Thank you very much.

10 MS. MILLER: All right. Thank you.

11 MR. ROBINSON: Thank you. Appreciate it.
