CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Good morning, ladies and gentlemen. I would like to welcome you to the regularly scheduled meeting of the District of Columbia Alcoholic Beverage Control Board. Today is November 12, 2014.

My name is Ruthanne Miller. I'm the Chairperson. Joining me today to my far right is Mr. Donald Brooks. And next to Mr. Brooks is Mr. Nick Alberti. And to my immediate right is Mr. Hector Rodriguez. To my immediate left is Mr. Mike Silverstein. And next to Mr. Silverstein is Mr. James Short. We have five Members in attendance this morning, with three constituting a quorum. I'm sorry, six Members.

Copies of today's hearing calendar and agenda are available at the receptionist desk. Please be aware that these proceedings are being recorded by a court reporter.

Accordingly, we must ask you to refrain from any disruptive noises or actions in the hearing room.

If you have any electronic devices, pagers, cell phones or such, please, make certain they are turned off to avoid any interruption of the proceedings.

When I call your case, please,
come forward and take a seat at one of the
tables. You will note there is a piece of
paper on each table for you to sign-in. This
is to ensure the correct spelling of your name
for the record.

14	briefly.
15	CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.
16	MS. GEPHARDT: We just need to
17	speak to some people to try to figure out
18	something.
19	CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. That's
20	fine.
21	CHAIRPERSON MILLER: So if we
22	could go to the next case?

1	CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.
2	(Whereupon, the above-entitled
3	matter went off the record at 9:43 a.m. and
4	resumed at 9:49 a.m.)
5	MR. MALIK: Good morning,
6	everybody.
7	CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. We are
8	ready. We are calling the case of Fiesta
9	Restaurant and Lounge, correct? Okay. Case
10	No. 14-AUD-00032. You can have a seat.
11	COURT REPORTER: Ms. Miller, could
12	you turn on your mike?
13	CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Right. I
14	did. Okay. Case No. 14-AUD-00032, Fiesta
15	Restaurant and Lounge is being recalled.
16	Okay. Would you introduce
17	yourselves for the record, please?
18	MS. GEPHARDT: Chrissy Gephardt on
19	behalf of the Office of the Attorney General
20	for the District of Columbia.
21	MR. MALIK: Raj Malik.
22	CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. And

1	are you the owner?
2	MR. MALIK: (No audible answer.)
3	CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Are you the
4	owner?
5	MR. MALIK: No.
6	CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All right.
7	What is your
8	COURT REPORTER: Is your
9	microphone on?
10	MS. GEPHARDT: Oh, here, hold on.
11	MR. MALIK: Taj Mahal Enterprises.
12	MS. GEPHARDT: No, no, no. Yes,
13	yes. Thanks.
14	CHAIRPERSON MILLER: I'm sorry,
15	could you repeat that?
16	MS. GEPHARDT: No, it's on. It's
17	on.
18	CHAIRPERSON MILLER: And what's
19	your relation to the Fiesta Restaurant and
20	Lounge?
21	MR. MALIK: (No audible answer.)
22	CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Are you the

1	owner?
2	MR. MALIK: (No audible answer.)
3	CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Well, let me
4	see who are you with? Would you introduce
5	yourself?
6	MR. TULI: May I explain on his
7	behalf, if you don't mind?
8	CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Could
9	you yes, the microphone is on the table.
10	Okay.
11	MR. TULI: Okay. I'm sorry. Mr.
12	Malik is the owner of the Taj Mahal
13	Enterprises.
14	CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.
15	MR. TULI: He has the license.
16	CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Okay.
17	MR. TULI: I was operating under
18	his license trading as Fiesta, Inc.
19	CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.
20	MR. TULI: My name is Sanjeen
21	Tuli. His name is Raj Malik.
22	CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. And I

1	need to ask you all if you got notice of this
2	hearing? Did you receive notice?
3	MR. TULI: Ma'am, the true fact is
4	that we did receive the notice in the month of
5	for the audit in the month of January.
6	During that time, I was traveling, so we asked
7	for an extension. And the unfortunate part is
8	that the restaurant always used to be closed
9	in the morning and it was only opening in the
LO	evening.
11	We never received the notice for
12	the second time that the audit was supposed to
13	take place.
14	CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. So I'm
15	really asking about the notice for this
