The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board met in the Alcoholic Beverage Control Hearing Room, Reeves Building, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009, Chairperson Ruthanne Miller, presiding.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Good morning, ladies and gentlemen. I would like to welcome you to the regularly scheduled meeting of the District of Columbia Alcoholic Beverage Control Board. Today is November 12, 2014.

My name is Ruthanne Miller. I'm the Chairperson. Joining me today to my far right is Mr. Donald Brooks. And next to Mr. Brooks is Mr. Nick Alberti. And to my immediate right is Mr. Hector Rodriguez. To my immediate left is Mr. Mike Silverstein.

And next to Mr. Silverstein is Mr. James
Short. We have five Members in attendance
this morning, with three constituting a quorum. I'm sorry, six Members.

Copies of today's hearing calendar and agenda are available at the receptionist desk. Please be aware that these proceedings are being recorded by a court reporter.

Accordingly, we must ask you to refrain from any disruptive noises or actions in the hearing room.

If you have any electronic
devices, pagers, cell phones or such, please, make certain they are turned off to avoid any interruption of the proceedings.

When I call your case, please, come forward and take a seat at one of the tables. You will note there is a piece of paper on each table for you to sign-in. This is to ensure the correct spelling of your name for the record.

## The Open Meetings Act requires

that the public hearing on each case be open to the public. The Board may, consistent with Section $405(\mathrm{~b})$ of the Open Meetings Act, enter a closed meeting during or after the public hearing on a case to consult with an attorney to obtain legal advice, discuss settlement agreements or deliberate upon a decision in an adjudication proceeding.

So that concludes my introductory remarks and we can now turn to this morning's calendar.

The first case on the calendar is Case No. 14-AUD-00032, Fiesta Restaurant and Lounge located at 1327 Connecticut Avenue, N.W., License No. 882, in ANC-2B.

MS. GEPHARDT: Madam Chair, before we start, I wanted to ask --

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. We are ready. We are calling the case of Fiesta Restaurant and Lounge, correct? Okay. Case No. 14-AUD-00032. You can have a seat.

COURT REPORTER: Ms. Miller, could you turn on your mike?

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Right. I
did. Okay. Case No. 14-AUD-00032, Fiesta
Restaurant and Lounge is being recalled.
Okay. Would you introduce
yourselves for the record, please?
MS. GEPHARDT: Chrissy Gephardt on behalf of the Office of the Attorney General for the District of Columbia.

MR. MALIK: Raj Malik.
CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. And
are you the owner?
MR. MALIK: (No audible answer.)
CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Are you the
owner?
MR. MALIK: No.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All right.
What is your --
COURT REPORTER: Is your
microphone on?
MS. GEPHARDT: Oh, here, hold on.

MR. MALIK: Taj Mahal Enterprises.
MS. GEPHARDT: No, no, no. Yes,
yes. Thanks.
CHAIRPERSON MILLER: I'm sorry,
could you repeat that?
MS. GEPHARDT: No, it's on. It's
on.

## CHAIRPERSON MILLER: And what's

your relation to the Fiesta Restaurant and Lounge?

MR. MALIK: (No audible answer.)
CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Are you the
owner?

MR. MALIK: (No audible answer.)

CHAIRPERSON MILIER: Well, let me see who are you with? Would you introduce yourself?

MR. TULI: May I explain on his behalf, if you don't mind?

CHAIRPERSON MIILER: Okay. Could you -- yes, the microphone is on the table. Okay.

MR. TULI: Okay. I'm sorry. Mr.

Malik is the owner of the Taj Mahal Enterprises.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

MR. TULI: He has the license.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Okay.

MR. TULI: I was operating under
his license trading as Fiesta, Inc.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

MR. TULI: My name is Sanjeen

Tuli. His name is Raj Malik.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. And I
need to ask you all if you got notice of this hearing? Did you receive notice?

MR. TULI: Ma'am, the true fact is that we did receive the notice in the month of -- for the audit in the month of January.

During that time, I was traveling, so we asked for an extension. And the unfortunate part is that the restaurant always used to be closed in the morning and it was only opening in the evening.

We never received the notice for the second time that the audit was supposed to take place.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. So I'm really asking about the notice for this hearing.

MR. TULI: For this hearing?

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: I mean, you
are here.

MR. TULI: Yes, Mr. Malik received the notice.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. And
