6 Toscana Café, 601 Second Street Northeast,  
7 License #ABRA 097558. This is a retailer class  
8 DR, Substantial change, class CR to DR, the  
9 protest issues are adverse impact on peace,  
10 order and quiet. My name is Laverne Fletcher.  
11 I am conducting the roll call hearing as the  
12 Board's agent pursuant to D.C. official code  
13 1601.2. Introductions beginning with the  
14 applicant.

15 MR. SOLOMON: My name is Richard Solomon.  
16 I am the manager of the Toscana Café.

17 MEDIATOR FLETCHER: And Mr. Solomon,
