COOPERATIVE (VOLUNTARY) AGREEMENT

Made this 9th day of October 2007 by and between Wisdom, ("Applicant") and Advisory Neighborhood Commission 6B, (the ANC) (collectively, the "Parties").

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, Applicant's application for a Retailers' Class "CT" license for premises, 1432 Pennsylvania, Avenue, SE, Washington, D.C. 20003, ABC License #77708, is now pending before the District of Columbia Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (ABC); and,

WHEREAS, the premises is within the boundaries of the ANC; and,

WHEREAS, the parties desire to enter into an agreement governing certain understandings regarding the issue of a Retailers' Class "CT" Liquor License at the subject premises;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

1. Applicant shall not provide, or permit, live music or live entertainment at the Premises, including but not limited to disc jockeys, without an Entertainment Endorsement.
2. Any music provided on the Premises shall not be audible inside of any other premises at any time.
3. Applicant shall not extend any sound system or speakers to the outside of the Premises.
4. Picking up trash, including beverage bottles and can, on a daily basis.
5. Sweep the outside of the establishment on a daily basis.
6. Applicant will not allow patrons to use the rear exit for any purpose other than for emergencies.
7. Applicant will not take out trash/bottles to rear trash bin after 3:00 a.m. after weekend shifts or 2:00 a.m. after weekday shifts.
8. Applicant will not allow a smoking or lounging area in the rear of the establishment at any time.
9. Taking due diligence to prevent vermin infestation in and around the establishment, including following the recommendations and guidelines of the Vector Control Division of the Department of Public Works.
10. Applicant will not operate the Premises as a nightclub, dance venue, or similar venue.
11. Applicant shall post a sign near the door inside the Premises requesting that patrons are quiet when leaving the Premises.
12. The Applicant agrees to close (discontinue service) the sidewalk cafe at 11:00 p.m. each night.

The parties further agree that any failure of Applicant to adhere to the foregoing commitment would constitute grounds for the ANC to petition the ABC Board for issuance of an order to show cause pursuant to 23 D.C.M.R. 1513.5.
