ORDER ON SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The official records of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) reflect that La Jambe, LLC, t/a La Jambe (Licensee), and ANC 6E have entered into a Settlement Agreement (Agreement), dated June 7 2016, that governs the operation of the Licensee's establishment.

The Agreement has been reduced to writing and has been properly executed and filed with the Board. The Licensee and Vice Chairperson Alexander M. Padro, on behalf of ANC 6E, are signatories to the Agreement.

Accordingly, it is this 22nd day of June, 2016, **ORDERED** that:

1. The above-referenced Settlement Agreement submitted by the parties to govern the operations of the Licensee's establishment is **APPROVED** and **INCORPORATED** as part of this Order, except for the following modification:

Section 1 – The language “3:00 PM” shall be replaced for the language “3:00 AM.”


The parties have agreed to this modification.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).

**AGREEMENT BETWEEN
LA JAMBE, LLC, T/A LA JAMBE
AND ADVISORY NEIGHBORHOOD COMMISSION 6E**

This Agreement between La Jambe, LLC t/a La Jambe, hereinafter referred to as the "Applicant" or the "Establishment," and Advisory Neighborhood Commission 6E, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission," codifies the agreement between the parties. This Agreement was approved by the Commission at its September 1, 2015 meeting, when the Applicant sought the Commission's support for the issuance of a Retailer's Class "C" Tavern license under License No. ABRA-099738 and is subject to approval by the District of Columbia Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (hereinafter referred to as the "Board"). The Establishment is located at 1550 7th Street, NW, Washington, DC 20001.


The parties agree to the following:

- 1) The Establishment's hours of operation shall not exceed the following: Sunday-Thursday, 7:00 AM to 2:00 AM, and Friday-Saturday, 7:00 AM-3:00 AM, inclusive of holidays. The Establishment's hours of alcoholic beverage sales, service, and consumption shall not exceed the following: Sunday-Thursday, 8:00 AM-2:00 AM, and Friday-Saturday, 8:00 AM-3:00 PM, inclusive of holidays. This will not preclude the Establishment applying for the ability to serve alcohol at additional hours if the opportunity to do so is provided for under law, such as presidential inaugurations, world sporting events, etc.
- 2) The hours of operation for the sidewalk cafe shall not exceed the following: Sunday-Saturday, 7:00 AM-12:00AM, inclusive of holidays. The hours of alcoholic beverage sales, service and consumption for the Establishment's sidewalk café shall not exceed the following: Sunday-Saturday, 8:00 AM-12 AM, inclusive of holidays.
- 3) There will be no amplified or unamplified music of any kind in the sidewalk café.
