ORDER GRANTING ANC 2B'S REQUEST FOR REINSTATEMENT

The Application filed by M Street Management Group, LLC, t/a 1819 Club, for renewal of its Retailer's Class CN License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on April 28, 2014, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).

On April 28, 2014, the Board dismissed the Protest of ANC 2B, because ANC 2B failed to appear at the Roll Call Hearing. *See* Board Order No. 2014-137.

On May 11, 2014, Chairperson Will Stephens, on behalf of ANC 2B, filed a request for reinstatement indicating that the ANC 2B failed to attend the Roll Call Hearing because of confusion regarding which ANC Commissioner was delegated to attend the Roll Call Hearing.

The Applicant consented to ANC 2B's request for reinstatement.

Upon consideration of this request to reinstate the Protest of ANC 2B, the Board finds that ANC 2B's explanation of an ANC's representative failure to appear constitutes good cause to reinstate the Protest of ANC 2B pursuant to 23 DCMR 1602.3. Additionally, ANC 2B's request was consented by the Applicant.

ORDER

For these reasons, the Board does hereby, this 21st day of May, 2014, **REINSTATE** the Protest of ANC 2B. Copies of this Order shall be sent to the Applicant and ANC 2B.





Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433, any Party adversely affected by this Order may file a Motion for Reconsideration within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 500 Indiana Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001. However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433, stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b).
