RESTATED VOLUNTARY AGREEMENT

Made this 8<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2006, by and between BUCA RESTAURANTS, INC., t/a Buca di Beppo ("the Applicant") and Advisory Neighborhood Commission 1C ("ANC 1C").

WHEREAS, the licensee and ANC 1C entered into that certain agreement dated February 16, 2001; and

WHEREAS, premises 1825 Connecticut Avenue, N.W. is within the jurisdiction boundaries of ANC 1C; and,

WHEREAS, the parties desire to enter into an agreement commemorating certain understandings regarding the licensee's operation, and to have such agreement supersede the parties agreement dated February 16, 2001,

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises above recited, and the covenants and promises set forth below, the parties agree as follows:


1. The licensee's hours of operation, including during which alcoholic beverages may be served, are from 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m. (midnight) seven days a week.
2. The licensee will not promote nor participate in any bar or pub "crawls" or events otherwise promoting the excessive consumption of alcoholic beverages.
3. The licensee will meet with representatives of ANC 1C upon notice to address issues of common concern, including, but not limited to, residential parking issues. The licensee acknowledges that it will make best efforts to encourage its patrons to park in nearby commercial garages or other off-street commercial parking establishments.
4. Applicant will abide by all D.C. laws, codes, and regulations relative to, but not limited to, noise and trash removal.
5. The parties agree that this Restated Voluntary Agreement shall supersede that certain Agreement dated February 16, 2001, between the licensee and ANC 1C.
