The application, having been protested came before the Board for public hearing on June 11, 1997 and was continued until June 25, 1997, in accordance with D.C. Code Section 25-115(c)(5)(1996 Supp.), providing for remonstrants to be heard. Isaac Long, on behalf of the 1700 Block of Swann Street, Martha Logan, F. Carl Matthei, III, and Maria Haber filed timely protests by letters dated May 26 and May 27, 1997.

The official records of the Board reflect that the parties have now reached an Agreement which has been reduced to writing, and has been properly executed and filed with the Board. Pursuant to the Agreements dated July 31, 1997 and September 24, 1997, the protestants have agreed to withdraw the opposition, provided however, the Board's approval of the pending application is conditioned.

that:




2. The above-referenced Agreement between the parties, be, and the same hereby, is **INCORPORATED** as part of this Order;

4. Copies of this Order shall be sent to the Protestants, the Attorney for the Applicant, and the Applicant.





VOLUNTARY AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made this 24th day of Sept, 1997, by and between Lauriol Plaza, Inc. ("Applicant") and Isaac Long, Martha Logan and Susan Huke ("Protestants").

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, Applicant has entered into a lease for the property located at the corner of 18th and T Street, NW, sometimes known as 1835 18th Street, NW (the "Premises"), and plans to construct a restaurant facility with parking (the "Project");

WHEREAS, Applicant has applied for approval for transfer of a retailer's license class CR issued by the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board of the District of Columbia to the Premises for the operation of the restaurant known as Lauriol Plaza, currently located and operated at 1801 18th Street, NW, Washington, DC; and

WHEREAS, the parties have agreed to enter into this Voluntary Agreement and to request the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board to approve the issuance of Applicant's transfer application conditioned upon Applicant's compliance with the terms of this written Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the recitals set forth above and the mutual covenants and conditions set forth below, the parties agree as follows:

1. The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein by reference.
2. Applicant agrees that in the construction of its new restaurant and development of the property, the "Garden Wall" designated and identified on the plan attached hereto as Exhibit A, shall extend from the T Street entrance to the parking area to the western wall of the house located at 1778 T Street, NW, Washington, DC. In addition, the gate to the

parking area entrance from T Street shall be kept closed, except for ingress and egress of vehicles, during all hours that the restaurant is closed to the public.

3. Applicant shall contract with a trash company to have trash picked up from the Premises at least once per day, including Sundays. The contract shall provide that the trash contractor shall access the loading dock of the Premises from the alley running along the south side of the Premises and that the trash contractor shall not enter or exit the lot upon which the Premises is located from the T Street parking entrance and shall only remove trash from and around the premises between 7:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.

4. Applicant shall use its best efforts to have an area on 18th Street adjacent to the Premises designated as a "Loading Zone". Applicant shall require liquor distributors, food purveyors and other vendors to unload trucks in the loading zone and transport the materials by hand truck or cart to the front entrances or the service entrance located in the rear of the building.

5. Applicant shall improve the appearance of the house located at 1778 T Street, NW as follows:

- A. The existing wire fence will be replaced with an iron ornamental fence.
- B. The exterior facade of the house, including the rear, shall be painted.
- C. A garden area will be developed in front of the house consistent in appearance and location with the existing garden adjacent to the north boundary of the Premises on T Street.

6. Applicant shall retain and maintain the existing garden on T Street adjacent to the Premises except for that portion of the garden to be removed in connection with access to

the parking area.

7. Applicant shall plant trees and shrubs along the southern and eastern boundaries of the Adjacent R-5-B Lot as shown on Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

8. Applicant shall use its best efforts to hire District of Columbia residents when filling new positions.

9. Applicant shall not provide recorded music or other entertainment on the outside roof top terrace of the premises or in Applicant's sidewalk cafe.

10. Protestants hereby withdraw their protest and join with Applicant in requesting the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board to accept this Agreement as a condition of approval to the transfer of Applicant's license. Protestants also agree to support Applicant's public space permit application for sidewalk cafe use on the 18th Street side of the Premises as shown on Exhibit A and any permits or appeals which Applicant may seek in connection with the continuing use for parking of the residential lots adjacent to the Premises including approval by the Board of Zoning Adjustment.

11. This Agreement may be executed simultaneously in two or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original and all of which, when taken together, constitute one and the same document. The signature of any party to any counterpart shall be deemed a signature to, and may be appended to, any other counterpart.



Kemplay, Single Member District Commissioner, on behalf of Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 1C09, Carmen Pages, Pedro Auger, Bonnie Miluso, Camille Grosdider, Anthony Cholst, Michael Guzman, and Susan Guzman filed timely opposition. On January 29, 2003, a motion to allow ANC 2B to represent ANC 1C due to the redistricting of the ANC's boundaries was argued before the Board. The Board granted the motion, and Vince Micone, Chairman of ANC 2B, became the representative for the protestants in this matter. However, by letter dated June 23, 2003, Vince Micone for ANC 1C, withdrew the protest against the applicant.

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


1. The protest of Vince Micone, representative for Advisory Neighborhood Commission 1C, is **WITHDRAWN**;

3. Copies of this Order shall be sent to the Protestants, the Representative for the Protestants, the Attorney for the Applicant, and the Applicant.




