

TIPS FOR ESTABLISHMENTS DURING MAJOR EVENTS

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE REGULATION ADMINISTRATION



OVERCROWDING

Establishments must not exceed their allotted occupancy, including on rooftop decks, Sidewalk Cafes, and Summer Gardens.



HOURS OF OPERATION

Establishments must adhere to the hours of operation and sales listed on their ABC license.



LAST CALL

Licensees should establish a last call for alcohol sales, giving ample time for patrons to finish their drinks and leave the premises, as well as staff enough time to close out tabs and finish operations.



NOISE

Establishments should avoid amplified telecasts of the game that may reach other premises. Keeping doors and windows closed helps to mitigate noise.



GLASS

ABRA advises establishments to use paper or plastic cups on Sidewalk Cafes and Summer Gardens.



BACKUP DRINKS

Establishments must ensure that patrons are not served multiple drinks at one time except as permitted by law, such as buckets of beer.



ON PREMISES

Licensees must not permit patrons to leave an on-premises establishment with alcohol.



ENDORSEMENTS

Establishments are not permitted to set up or utilize outdoor areas for which they do not have an endorsement.



ID CHECKS

Establishments must ensure proper examination of identity documents to verify proof of age before selling or serving alcohol.



MONITOR

ABC Managers, waitresses, and bartenders must monitor alcohol consumption by patrons to avoid over serving.



TRASH

Establishments are required to routinely empty trash and maintain a reasonably clean environment outside of their premises.



ABC MANAGER

Owners or ABC Managers must be present during licensed hours of sales.
