#### VOLUNTARY AGREEMENT

Made this 18th day of June 2007 by and between Jandara, Inc., t/a Jandara (the Applicant) and Advisory Neighborhood Commission 3F, North Cleveland Park, Forest Hills, and Tenleytown (the ANC).

WHEREAS, pending before the District of Columbia Alcoholic Beverage Control Board, is the Applicant's application for a Retailer's Class "CR" liquor license for its premises at 4237 Wisconsin Avenue, N.W., License #26494, Application #7970; and

WHEREAS, both Applicant and the ANC ("the parties") desire to enter into an agreement commemorating certain understandings regarding Applicant's operating plans;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises above recited, and the mutual covenants and promises set forth below, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Applicant shall operate a bona fide restaurant on its premises.
- 2. The restaurant shall have a maximum of 90 seats for the exclusive use of dining patrons, including up to 6 seats at the bar.
- 3. Applicant's hours of operation will be 11:30 a.m. to 10:30 p.m., Sunday through Thursday, and 11:30 a.m. to 11:00 p.m., Friday and Saturday.
- 4. Alcoholic beverages will be served primarily in conjunction with full meal service. Applicant shall offer food service to its patrons at all times it is open. At no time shall a patron be able to purchase an alcoholic beverage from the Applicant and not be able to purchase food from the Applicant.
- 5. Applicant plans to offer take-out and delivery food service, but Applicant will not provide alcoholic beverages on a take-out or delivery basis.
- 6. Applicant shall present no form of live entertainment and no form of recorded music other than soft background music for dining.
- 7. Applicant shall permit no form of dancing.
- 8. Applicant shall not install or utilize any juke boxes or equipment for video games. Applicant may install equipment for the showing of videos, to be limited to one (1) screen no larger than 20" for the showing of sports programming at the bar and one (1) screen no larger than 32" in the restaurant for the showing of cultural videos of Thailand.
- 9. Applicant will post no signs advertising liquor sales, happy hours, or the like.
- 10. Applicant shall comply with all aspects of the Civil Infractions Act and the Litter Control Administration Act. Applicant shall ensure that its trash is removed in a timely manner. Applicant shall ensure that trash receptacles remain closed and free or vermin at all times.

Applicant will limit noise after closing when disposing of trash and bottles in the receptacles.

- 11. Applicant shall maintain its ventilating system in proper working order at all times and shall immediately address any neighborhood concerns regarding odors.
- 12. Applicant shall be responsible for maintaining the public space bordering the restaurant.
- 13. Applicant shall comply with Section 5(d)(3) of the D.C. Noise Control Act as it pertains to businesses and ensure that noise from all mechanical equipment (air-conditioning, refrigerator, heat pump, fan, or other mechanical equipment regardless of location) shall be prohibited in excess of sixty (60) dB when measured at the property line or as close to the property line as practical if there is an obstruction.
- 14. An ABC licensed manager, conversant with all aspects of this agreement, shall be on site at Applicant's premises during all hours of operation.
- 15. Any and all contemplated changes to Applicant's operation, as set forth herein or otherwise, will be brought to the attention of the ANC prior to implementation and will be implemented only after ANC approval, and when required by rules and regulations, ABC Board approval.
- 16. In consideration of and in reliance upon the commitments reflected in paragraphs 1-15 above, the ANC will advise the ABC Board that it does not oppose Applicant's pending application for Retailer's Class "CR" license.
- 17. The parties further agree that any failure of Applicant to adhere to the foregoing commitments would constitute grounds for the ANC to petition the ABC Board for issuance of an order to show cause to gain the Applicant's compliance with the terms of this Agreement.

WHEREAS, pending before the District of Columbia Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (ABC), is the Applicant's application to renew a Class CR license for its premises at 4400 Connecticut Avenue. NW, ABC application # 7970; and WHEREAS, the parties desire to enter into an agreement commemorating certain understandings regarding Applicant's operating plans; NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises above recited, and the mutual covenants and promises set forth below, the parties agree as follows: 1. Applicant shall operate a *bona fide* restaurant on its premises. 2. The restaurant shall have a maximum of 90 seats for the exclusive use of dining patrons. Alcoholic beverages will be served primarily in conjunction with full meal service. 3. The bar/lounge area will have a maximum of 6 seats for the primary use of patrons waiting for dining service. 4. The Applicant's hours of operation shall be 11:30am to 10:30pm , Monday through Thursday; 11:30am to 11:00pm , Friday and Saturday; and 11:30am to 10:30pm , Sunday. 5. Applicant shall admit no patrons to its premises after the hour of 10:30pm , Monday through Thursday; 11:00pm , Friday and Saturday; and 10:30pm , Sunday.

6. Applicant shall present no form of live entertainment and no form of recorded

music other than soft background music for dining.

7. Applicant shall permit no form of dancing.

- 8. Applicant shall not install or utilize any equipment for the showing of videos; juke boxes; or video games.
- 9. Applicant shall comply with all aspects of the Civil Infractions Act and the Litter Control Administration Act. Applicant shall make every effort to keep the establishment's immediate surroundings litter-free. Any alleged violations left uncorrected may be referred by the ANC to the appropriate agency.
- 10. Applicant will care for the public spaces that border the restaurant on Wisconsin Avenue, including provision of suitable plantings, such as bulbs and grass or perennial plants.
- 11. An ABC licensed manager, conversant with all aspects of this agreement, shall be on site at Applicant's premises during all hours of operation.
- 12. Any and all contemplated changes to Applicant's operation that would conflict with this voluntary agreement will be brought to the attention of the ANC prior to implementation and will be implemented only after ANC approval, and when required by rules and regulations, ABC Board approval.
- 13. In consideration of and in reliance upon the commitments reflected in paragraphs 1-12 preceding, the ANC will advise the ABC Board that it has no objection to Applicant's pending license application.
- 14. The parties further agree that any failure of Applicant to adhere to the foregoing commitments would constitute grounds for the ANC to petition the ABC Board for issuance of an order to show cause pursuant to 23 DCMR 1513.5, to gain the Applicant's compliance with the terms of this Agreement.
