CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Would the parties in the matter of State Tavern please come forward? The parties in the matter of State Tavern please come forward. This is Case #16-PRO-00013, 51st, LLC, trading as 51st State, 2512 L Street Northwest, License ABRA 071-333.

This is Retailer Class CT, substantial change, entertainment endorsement including a disc jockey and an acoustic guitar. The protest are adverse impact on peace, order and quiet.
