


Accordingly, it is this 8<sup>th</sup> day of June 2011, **ORDERED** that:

2. Copies of this Order shall be sent to the Applicant and ANC 3E.





### **Resolution Regarding Application by Capital Wine School for Retail Class D Tavern License to Serve Alcoholic Beverages, ABRA-086613**

**Whereas**, The Capital Wine School LLC ("Capital Wine School") has sought permission from the District of Columbia Alcoholic Beverage Administration (ABRA) to serve alcoholic beverages in a room to be located at 5207 Wisconsin Avenue NW, Suite 7, and

**Whereas**, the Capital Wine School entered into the attached voluntary agreement with Advisory Neighborhood Commission 3E at its April 12<sup>th</sup>, 2011 meeting and

**Whereas**, the voluntary agreement permits use of the aforementioned facility by applicant and any successor licensee solely for the purposes of operating a wine school and

**Whereas**, in this voluntary agreement the applicant has also committed to discourage driving and to seek out parking for its customers and

**Whereas**, with the provisions of this voluntary agreement in place ANC 3E believes the benefits to the neighborhood of granting the license will likely outweigh any burdens imposed,

**Now therefore be it resolved**, ANC 3E supports Capital Wine School's application for a Retail Class D Tavern License, provided that it adheres to the attached voluntary agreement, and

**Be it further resolved**, ANC 3E respectfully asks ABRA to embody the conditions specified in the voluntary agreement in any order granting the license sought by Capital Wine School.

ANC 3E approved this resolution at its meeting on May 12, 2011, which was properly noticed and at which a quorum was present. The resolution was approved by a vote of 5-0-0. Commissioners Jonathan Bender, Matthew Frumin, Tom Quinn, Sam Serebin and Beverly Sklover were present.
