**ORDER ON DISMISSAL OF AN INDIVIDUAL PROTESTANT AS PART
OF A GROUP OF FIVE OR MORE INDIVIDUALS**

The Application filed by Jungbyun, Incorporated, t/a 7th & L Street Market, for renewal of its Retailer's Class B License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on November 28, 2011, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).

On November 28, 2011, pursuant to Title 23 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations (23 DCMR) § 1602.3 (2004), the Board dismissed Mark Batterson, as a protestant with the Group of Five or More Individuals, because the address on Mr. Batterson's protest letter is 701 Virginia Avenue, S.E. Washington, D.C., which is National Community Church's address and a church does not have standing, pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-601. In addition, Mr. Batterson was not present at the Roll Call Hearing to clarify how he intended to file his protest. Mr. Batterson may file a Request for Reinstatement within ten (10) days from the date of this Order.
