ORDER GRANTING APPLICANT'S REQUEST FOR REINSTATEMENT

The Application filed by Elisa Alabama, Inc., t/a Alabama Convenience, for renewal of its Retailer's Class B License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on December 5, 2011 and a Protest Status Hearing on January 25, 2012, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).

On January 25, 2012, pursuant to Title 23 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations (23 DCMR) § 1602.3 (2004), the Board dismissed the Application, because the Applicant failed to appear at the Protest Status Hearing.

On February 8, 2012, Elisa Om, Elisa Alabama, Inc.'s owner, filed a request for reinstatement, indicating that she failed to attend the Protest Status Hearing, because she was sick. In addition, Wednesdays are the busiest days for the business and two employees were also sick, which prevent Hoil Om, Elisa Alabama, Inc.'s General Manger, to attend the Protest Status Hearing on behalf of the Licensee.

ORDER






