ORDER ON DISMISSAL OF ERICA HURTT’S PROTEST

The Application filed by All Souls, LLC, t/a All Souls, for a Substantial Change to change its hours and include a new Sidewalk Café, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on June 29, 2015, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).

On June 29, 2015, the Board dismissed the Protest of Erica Hurtt, Abutting Property Owner, because Ms. Hurtt failed to appear at the Roll Call Hearing. Ms. Hurtt may file a Request for Reinstatement with the Board within ten (10) days from the date of this Order.

The Board's agent advised the Group of Five or More Individuals at the Roll Call Hearing that at least two more individual must appear at the Protest Status Hearing to be granted standing as A Group of Five or More Individuals. The Group of Five or More Individuals was granted conditional standing at the Roll Call Hearing.


ORDER

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433, any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
