ORDER DENYING THE APPLICANT'S REQUEST FOR REINSTATEMENT

The Application filed by Appioo, LLC, t/a Appioo (Applicant), for renewal of its Retailer's Class CR License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Protest Status Hearing on September 7, 2016, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).

On September 7, 2016, the Board dismissed the Application because the Applicant failed to appear at the Protest Status Hearing. *See* Board Order No. 2016-502, dated September 7, 2016.

On October 5, 2016, Prince Matey, on behalf of the Applicant, submitted a Request for Reinstatement. The deadline for receipt of the Request for Reinstatement was September 21, 2016, ten (10) days from the date of the Order No. 2016-502. However, the Applicant's Request for Reinstatement was received by Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) on October 5, 2016; therefore, its request is considered untimely filed.


The Board finds that the Applicant's Request for Reinstatement was untimely filed, and the Board finds no good cause to reinstate the Application, pursuant to 23 DCMR §1603.5.

ORDER

For these reasons, the Board does hereby, this 26th day of October, 2016, **DENY** the reinstatement of the Application filed by Appioo, LLC, t/a Appioo, for renewal of its Retailer's Class CR License.



Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
