
**ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION**

On February 24, 2010, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (the "Board") issued an Order on Denial of Application for Licensure ("Order") based on the Fact Finding Hearing in the matter involving Assab Corporation t/a B & V Market ("Applicant"). As a result of the Fact Finding Hearing, the Board determined that the Applicant was not fit for licensure and denied the Application. *See* Board Order Number 2010-052.

Pursuant to §25-433(d)(1), the Applicant filed a Motion for Reconsideration ("Motion") as a result of the Board's Order. The Board has reviewed Board Order Number 2009-052 and finds that it was proper based on the Board's findings of fact gleaned from the evidence presented by the Applicant at the time of the hearing. Additionally, the Applicant's Motion fails to state the matters of record alleged to have been erroneously decided, the grounds relied upon, or the relief sought as required under DCMR §1719.3.





Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code § 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 500 Indiana Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001. However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR § 1719.1 (April 2004) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b).
