ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR REINSTATEMENT

The Application filed by Bon Appetit Management Company, t/a Bon Appetit Mgt. Co., for a Renewal of its Retailer's Class DR License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) for a Roll Call Hearing on June 28, 2010, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).

On June 28, 2010, pursuant to Title 23 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations ("23 DCMR") § 1602.3 (2004), the Board dismissed the Protest because the Protestant failed to appear at the Roll Call Hearing. The Protestant filed a request for reinstatement with the Board explaining the reasons for not appearing. Upon consideration of this request to reinstate the Protestant, the Board finds good cause to reinstate Protestant pursuant to 23 D.C.M.R. 1602.3.


ORDER






