
**ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE**

The Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) has reviewed its records and determined that Brooklyn Flea DC, LLC, t/a Brooklyn Flea DC, (Respondent), has failed to pay the second year license fees for its License No. ABRA-094283, a Retailer's Class DT License. Specifically, the Respondent failed to make the second year payment for its license by September 30, 2014, the deadline for all Retailer's DT licenses, despite being notified by ABRA of the payment date.


On October 15, 2014, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) issued an Order to Cease and Desist against Brooklyn Flea DC, LLC, t/a Brooklyn Flea DC, pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-829 (2001), for failure to pay the second year license fees for its Retailer's Class DT License.

It is hereby **ORDERED** on this 12<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2014, that Brooklyn Flea DC, LLC's License No. ABRA-094283 is **CANCELLED**. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the Respondent.


