
ORDER APPROVING EXTENSION OF PETITION DEADLINE

By correspondence dated May 13, 2016, Shallamar Enterprises, LLC, t/a Capitol Hill Tandor and Grill (Applicant), and Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 6B requested an extension of the protest petition deadline pursuant to Section 1705.5 of Title 23 of the D.C. Municipal Regulations.

DCMR 1705.5 provides that the Board may, on the request of both the ANC and the Applicant, extend the ANC's protest petition deadline for the sole purpose of allowing the ANC to vote on whether to support or protest the license application.

Upon review and in accordance with DCMR 1705.5, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board, on this 18th day of May, 2016, **APPROVES** the request to extend the protest petition deadline. The new deadline is October 17, 2016. Copies of this Order shall be sent to the Applicant and ANC 6B.





Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
