By correspondence dated May 16, 2016, the Stronghold Civic Association (SCA) requested a continuance of the June 1, 2016 Protest Hearing.


In Board Order No. 2016-295, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) granted reinstatement of the Applicant's previously dismissed application. In doing so, it was necessary to reschedule the Protest Status Hearing, now set for May 25, 2016 at 9:30 a.m. Because only one week now separates the Protest Status Hearing from the Protest Hearing, SCA seeks additional time to prepare for the Protest Hearing.

Upon review of the request and in light of the Board's rescheduling of the Protest Status Hearing, the Board finds the SCA request constitutes good cause to continue the Protest Hearing.

ORDER

For these reasons, the Board does hereby, this 18th day of May, 2016, **APPROVE** the request to continue the Protest Hearing. The hearing is now scheduled for June 29, 2016 at 1:30 p.m. Copies of this Order shall be sent to the Applicant, ANC 5E, and SCA.



Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
