ORDER GRANTING ANC 8A'S REQUEST FOR REINSTATEMENT

The Application filed by Gebtri, Inc., t/a Cedar Hill Bar & Grill/Uniontown Bar & Grill, for a Substantial Change to change its entertainment endorsement hours, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on April 7, 2014, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).

On April 7, 2014, the Board dismissed the Protest of ANC 8A, because ANC 8A failed to appear at the Roll Call Hearing. *See* Board Order No. 2014-121.

On April 15, 2014, Chairperson Barbara Clark, on behalf of ANC 8A, filed a request for reinstatement indicating that she failed to attend the Roll Call Hearing due to rain and traffic. Due to the rain and the traffic, Chairperson Clark did not arrive until after the case was called and the hearing had concluded.

ORDER



Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433, any Party adversely affected by this Order may file a Motion for Reconsideration within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 500 Indiana Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001. However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433, stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b).
