On June 14, 2016, the District of Columbia (Government) filed a Praecipe of Dismissal seeking dismissal of the charges set forth in the Notice to Show Cause filed against Parkside Associates Limited Partnership, t/a Circle 7 Market (Respondent). *See* ABRA Show Cause File No. 15-CC-00145.

The Government seeks to dismiss because the Respondent settled the case through a Settlement Agreement executed by ABRA staff and paid the fine that formed the basis of the charges listed in the Show Cause Notice. Specially, the Respondent paid \$6,750.00 on June 10, 2016, to satisfy the amount owed for Case No. 15-CC-00145.

For these reasons, on this 29th day of June, 2016, the Board hereby **ACKNOWLEDGES** receipt of the Government's Praecipe of Dismissal and **DISMISSES** Case No. 15-CC-00145 against the Respondent. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the Respondent and the Government.



Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
