3 CHAIR ANDERSON: We're back on the
4 record. Our first matter is a public hearing on
5 our civil penalty rulemaking.

6 We're here today pursuant to DC
7 Official Code Section 25-830 to conduct a public
8 hearing and take comment on a proposed rulemaking
9 that amends the existing ABRA civil penalty
10 schedule, set in Section 800 of Title 23 of the
11 District of Columbia Municipal Regulations. The
12 civil penalty schedule was last updated in July
13 2018.

14 The proposed rules are intended to
15 update the existing schedule by, one, including
16 new infractions and penalties, two, removing
17 duplicate infractions, and three, amending the
18 descriptions of existing of existing infractions.

19 By way of background, the Board
20 approved the civil penalty schedule notice of
21 proposed rulemaking on September 11, 2019, 4-0.
22 On October 25, 2019, the proposed rulemaking was
23 published in the DC Register for notice and
24 public comment, see 66-DCR-14095 October 25,
25 2019.

1 ABRA did not receive any notification
2 from witnesses in advance of today's hearing
3 regarding their desire to address the Board.
4 Therefore, the Board will entertain comments from
5 anyone present today who wishes to be heard.
6 Please limit your comments to no more than five
7 minutes. If there is any time left, we will
8 grant additional time to the hearing. Is there
9 anyone here today in the audience who wants to
10 testify on the civil penalty schedule?

11 Hearing none, this hearing is then
12 adjourned. There are no witnesses present today
13 and so, therefore, this matter was advertised in
14 the DC Register and no one is here to testify,
15 and so, therefore, we will move forward with the
16 proposed rulemaking. Thank you.
