**ORDER ON WITHDRAWAL OF APPLICATION**


The Application filed by Omar, LLC, t/a Costello Restaurant and Lounge (Applicant) for a Substantial Change to change its hours and add entertainment endorsement to its Retailer's Class CT License, having been protested by a Group of Five or More Individuals came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on September 17, 2018, and a Protest Status Hearing on October 24, 2018.

Subsequent to these two hearings, but prior to the Protest Hearing, Amadou Bah, on behalf of the Applicant, submitted a written request dated January 29, 2019, seeking the withdrawal of the Application for a Substantial Change. There was no objection by the Protestants.

After reviewing the request, the Board, on this 30th day of January, 2019, deems the Application **WITHDRAWN** which terminates this matter and cancels all further hearings related to the protest.



Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
