**ORDER DENYING PETITION TO TERMINATE
A SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

The official records of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) reflect that Dangerously Delicious DC, LLC, t/a Dangerously Delicious DC (Petitioner), entered into a Settlement Agreement with Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 6A on September 1, 2011 and it was approved by the Board on September 28, 2011. The Petitioner now seeks to terminate its Settlement Agreement under D.C. Official Code § 25-446(d).

D.C. Official Code § 25-446(d)(2) provides that “The Board may accept an application to amend or terminate a settlement agreement by fewer than all parties in the following circumstances: (A) During the license’s renewal period; and (B) After 4 years from the date of the Board’s decision initially approving the settlement agreement.”

The Board finds that the Petitioner’s Settlement Agreement approved by the Board on September 28, 2011, does not meet the four (4) year criteria required by D.C. Official Code § 25-446(d)(2)(B).

Therefore, the Board denies the Petition to Terminate a Settlement Agreement because the Settlement Agreement sought to be terminated is not four (4) years old or older.


ORDER




