
ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE

The Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) has reviewed its records and determined that Desaber, LLC, t/a DiVinoSphere & DiVinoDirect, (Respondent), failed to renew its Retailer's Class B Wholesaler License No. ABRA-090658. Specifically, the Respondent failed to renew its license by September 30, 2014, the deadline for all Retailer's Class B Wholesaler licenses, despite being notified by ABRA of the renewal date.


On October 15, 2014, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) issued an Order to Cease and Desist against Desaber, LLC, t/a DiVinoSphere & DiVinoDirect, pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-829 (2001), for failure to renew its Retailer's Class B Wholesaler License.


