OFFER IN COMPROMISE<sup>1</sup>

This offer in compromise will be presented to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board by the Assistant Attorney General at the status hearing. Please be advised that this is a proposed compromise. Accordingly, it is the discretion of the Board to accept or reject this offer.

In addition to the suspension above, the offer in compromise consists of the following terms:

- (1) Upon expiration of the license suspension period, the license shall be deemed surrendered for safekeeping.
- (2) Submission to the Board, prior to retrieval of the license, of a revised security plan, which will address the requirements for a security plan under Title 25 of the D.C. Code, including:
  - a. Installation, operation, and recording of video cameras. The video must show the area in front of the establishment. The camera video tapes must be maintained for 30 days. The video must be available within 48 hours of a request by a law enforcement entity or ABRA.
  - b. Employment of MPD Reimbursable Detail in accordance Board Order 2011-402 (for at least 4 hours when there is entertainment until one hour after establishment closes).
  - c. Maintenance of a detailed incident log for one year to be made available to any law enforcement entity or ABRA upon request.
  - d. Detailed procedures addressing violent altercations in the establishment.

- (3) Payment to ABRA, prior to retrieval of the license, of all outstanding license fees.
- (4) Submission to the Board, prior to retrieval of the license, of a business plan.
- (5) The license shall only be returned to an officer having controlling interest in Bouzid, Inc.
- (6) In accordance with Board Order 2011-402, entertainment is limited to 1:00 a.m. Sunday through Thursday and 2:00 a.m. Friday and Saturday).

**CONSENT**

By this settlement agreement I agree to accept and perform its terms. I acknowledge the validity of the settlement and waive a hearing to which I would have a right under D.C. Official Code § 25-826 (2001). I also recognize that I am waiving any right to appeal an adverse ruling of the Board that might have followed any such hearing. By this settlement, I waive all such rights. I sign this settlement agreement without reservation, and I fully understand its meaning and my rights.
