**ORDER ON APPLICATION FOR EXCEPTION  
TO SINGLE SALE MORATORIUM**

On March 29, 2010, Dixie Liquors, Inc., t/a Dixie Liquors ("Applicant"), 3429 M Street, N.W., submitted an "Application for Exception to Single Sales Restrictions" ("Application") to the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration ("ABRA") for an exception to the statutory single sale moratorium that currently exists in Ward 2.


On April 8, 2010 and April 9, 2009, ABRA advised ANC 2E of the Application and requested input in determining whether granting the exception is in the best interest of the community and Licensee. On March 29, 2010, the Licensee also notified ANC 2E of the Application. ABRA nor the Licensee received a response from ANC 2E.

The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board ("Board") considered several factors in reaching its decision. This included the petition in support of the Application that included signatures of the Licensee's patrons, the absence or presence of any primary or secondary tier violations within 12 months preceding the date of the application, and

evidence regarding adverse community impact and other supporting documentation comprising the Board's official file.

Accordingly, the Board hereby, this 21<sup>st</sup> day of April, 2010, **APPROVES** the Application filed by Dixie Liquors, Inc. t/a Dixie Liquors, 3429 M Street, N.W., Washington, D.C, for an exception to the single sale moratorium in Ward 2. Copies of this Order shall be sent to the Applicant and to ANC 2E.




