**ORDER ON DISMISSAL OF PROTEST OF  
KETCHAM ELEMENTARY SCHOOL**

The Application filed by Good Hope Market, LLC, t/a Dollar Plus Store, for a new Retailer's Class A License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on September 9, 2013, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).

On September 9, 2013, the Board dismissed the Protest of Ketcham Elementary School, because a school is not a citizens association. Therefore, Ketcham Elementary School did not meet the standing requirements under D.C. Official Code § 25-601. Ketcham Elementary School may file a Request for Reinstatement with the Board within ten (10) days from the date of this Order.

### **ORDER**


