**ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR REINSTATEMENT**

The Application filed by Don Juan Restaurant, Inc., t/a Don Juan Restaurant & Carryout, for renewal of a Retailer's Class CR License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) for a Roll Call Hearing on July 6, 2010, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).

On July 6, 2010, pursuant to Title 23 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations ("23 DCMR") § 1602.3 (2004), the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) dismissed the Application and the Protest because the Applicant and the Protestants failed to appear at the Roll Call Hearing. Both the Applicant and the Protestants filed a request for reinstatement with the Board, explaining the reasons for not appearing. Upon consideration of this request to reinstate the Applicant and the Protestants, the Board finds good cause to reinstate Applicant and Protestants pursuant to 23 DCMR § 1602.3.


**ORDER**






