The Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) was informed that El Pulgarcito of America, LLC, t/a El Pulgarcito of America (Licensee), located at 5313 Georgia Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C., has ceased operations.


On October 27, 2014, ABRA's Licensing Division provided written notice to the Licensee notifying the Licensee that if it is no longer in operations, the license must be surrendered to the Board for safekeeping or the license will be cancelled, pursuant to the District of Columbia Official Code § 25-791. No response from the Licensee was received by ABRA. In addition, the Licensee's location is currently occupied by a new license-holder.

It is hereby **ORDERED** on this 12th day of November, 2014, that El Pulgarcito of America, LLC's License No. ABRA-076672 is **CANCELLED**. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the Licensee.







Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433, any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 500 Indiana Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001. However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433, stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b).
