1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Then we'll -- we'll  
3 move on to our show cause -- another show cause hearing  
4 status Case Number 16-CMP-00344, Fort Drum Market,  
5 License Number 96107. Will the parties please approach  
6 and identify themselves for the record please.

7 MR. KLINE: Thank you. Good morning again.  
8 Zachary Shapiro on behalf of the District of Columbia.

9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning again.

10 MR. DETS: Bernard C. Dets on behalf of  
11 the --

12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I'm sorry, sir. I  
13 didn't hear your name.

14 MR. DETS: Bernard C. Dets.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning  
16 Mr. Dets. Okay. And who's with you?

17 MR. DETS: And I have Mr. Petros  
18 Gribermesscall who is the president of the LLC.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Gribermesscall,  
20 can you identify yourself for the record and also write  
21 your name on the sign-in sheet please.

22 MR. GRIBERMESSCALL: Yeah. My name is

1 Petros Gribermesscall, and I'm the president of 4686  
2 MLK, LLC.

3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Just make sure that  
4 you write your name on the sign-in sheet please. All  
5 right. Are there any preliminary matters in this case?

6 MR. SHAPIRO: Yes, there is, Mr. Chairman.  
7 There's an Offer in Compromise.

8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And what is that  
9 please?

10 MR. SHAPIRO: It is a fine of \$550 payable  
11 in 30 days or the license will be suspended.

12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Gribermesscall  
13 and Mr. Dets --

14 MR. DETS: Dets.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. It's my  
16 understanding that there is an Offer in Compromise of a  
17 fine of \$550 payable in 30 days. Yeah, payable in 30  
18 days. If the fine not payable in 30 days, the license  
19 will be suspended. Is this your understanding of the  
20 Offer in Compromise?

21 MR. DETS: Yes, it is. And we agree to it.

22 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And on behalf of

1 your -- are you an attorney, sir?

2 MR. DETS: Yes, I am.

3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes. And --

4 MR. DETS: I just don't dress like one.

5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: No. I don't have a  
6 problem with that. I just want to -- I --

7 MR. DETS: It's 100 degrees out there.

8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I'm fine with that.  
9 I'm just saying I'm new so I don't know -- I know -- I  
10 look, he's the owner, and so I'm fine with it. I -- I  
11 don't have that -- but anyway. So on behalf of your  
12 client does your client -- is your client aware that by  
13 accepting this Offer in Compromise he's giving up his  
14 right to a hearing?

15 MR. DETS: Yes.

16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And does he also  
17 agree that by accepting this Offer in Compromise he is  
18 giving up his right to appeal this matter?

19 MR. DETS: Yes, I do.

20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. All  
21 right. Thank you. All right. I -- I make a motion  
22 that this Offer in Compromise of a fine of \$550 payable

1 in 30 days be accepted. If it's not payable in 30 days,  
2 the license will be suspended until the fine has been  
3 paid. Is there a second?

4 MR. ALBERTI: Second.

5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Alberti has  
6 seconded motion. Are there any discussions by any board  
7 members? Hearing none. All those in favor say aye.  
8 [Chorus of ayes]. All those opposed. [No audible  
9 response]. The matter passed 4-zero-zero.

10 Thank you very much, and we'll have you sign  
11 some documents. And thank you for agreeing to -- to  
12 streamline this process. Okay. All right. So we'll  
13 have some documents. Don't -- don't leave the room as  
14 yet. We're going to have you sign some documents  
15 please. Okay. Mr. -- all right. Mr. Dets --

16 MR. DETS: Dets.

17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Dets.

18 MR. DETS: Yes, sir.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Please don't leave  
20 the room. We're going to have you guys sign some --  
21 some paperwork. All right? All right. Thank you.
