ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE


The Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) has reviewed its records and determined that Yes East Potomac, Inc., t/a Fairlawn Market, (Respondent), failed to renew its Retailer's Class B License No. ABRA-084703. Specifically, the Respondent failed to renew its license by September 30, 2014, the deadline for all Retailer's Class B licenses, despite being notified by ABRA of the renewal date.


