**AMENDED FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW, AND ORDER**

On April 7, 2010, by Order No. 2010-053, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) found the Respondent, Masawa Corporation, t/a Far East Deli at premises 1612 Kenilworth Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C., holder of a Retailer's Class B License, violated D.C. Code § 25-823(1) (2009); D.C. Code § 25-823(5); D.C. Code § 25-342(b); D.C. Code § 25-342(c); District of Columbia Municipal Regulations 23 § 1208.1; and District of Columbia Municipal Regulations 23 § 1208.3. The Board ordered the Respondent to pay a fine in the amount of \$3,000.00 by no later than thirty (30) days from the date of the Order. Furthermore, the Respondent's license was suspended for fourteen (14) days; twelve (12) days served and two (2) days stayed for (1) year, provided that the Respondent did not commit any ABC violations.


The Board now seeks to amend Order No. 2010-053 to clarify that the Respondent is required to serve the twelve (12) days of suspension from May 7, 2010, through May 18, 2010. All other terms and conditions adopted by Order No. 2010-053 shall remain in full force and effect.

Accordingly, it is this 14th day of April 2010, **ORDERED** that:

1. Masawa Corporation, t/a Far East Deli at premises 1612 Kenilworth Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. holder of a Retailer's Class B License, will have its license suspended from May 7, 2010, through May 18, 2010.

2. All other terms and conditions of Order No. 2010-053 shall remain in full force and effect; and







Pursuant to Section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001) and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of the service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 500 Indiana Avenue, N.W., Washington D.C. 20001.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code § 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 500 Indiana Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001. However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR § 1719.1 (April 2004) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b).
