**ORDER VACATING CANCELLATION OF LICENSE AND
REINSTATING LICENSE**


On November 12, 2014, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) issued Board Order No. 2014-468 cancelling Saki, Inc., t/a Federal Lounge's (Licensee) License No. ABRA-091249. Specifically, the Licensee failed to pay the second year license fees for its License No. ABRA-091249 by September 30, 2014. *See* Board Order No. 2014-468.


On November 18, 2014, Paul L. Pascal, Esq., on behalf of Songbyrd, LLC (Petitioner), sought reinstatement of the Retailer's Class CR License No. ABRA-091249. In support of its request for reinstatement, Mr. Pascal stated that the Petitioner had a Transfer Application pending with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA). Furthermore, the Petitioner stated that there were circumstances beyond the Petitioner's control that led to the delinquency of the second year license fees payment. The Petitioner agrees to pay all the pending license fees and the associated late fees if its request is approved by the Board.


The Board finds that the reinstatement of the license is proper.



Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433, any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
