5 Number 90823. Would the parties please approach
6 to identify themselves for the record, please?

7 MS. YOHANNES: Sidon Yohannes on
8 behalf of the Applicant.

9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
10 Ms. Yohannes.

11 MS. YOHANNES: Good morning.

12 MS. NORMAN: Anita Norman on behalf of
13 ANC 1B.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good, excuse

13 So, the Board will, at some point
14 today when the Board issues its decisions it will
15 be reflected on our Board's decision. But the
16 Board is aware of your request regarding what
17 settlement agreement, what settlement, which of
18 the two settlement agreements is in place,
19 whether or not it's one or both.

20 So, we are aware of that. But the
21 Board is not prepared at this juncture to make a
22 decision on that issue, okay.

24 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Any other
25 preliminary matter?

1 MS. YOHANNES: Not for the Applicant.

6 hearings or are both parties fully versed and

9 MS. YOHANNES: So, is the Applicant.

11 thank you both.
