4 our calendar is Case No. 19-CIT-00524, Georgia
5 Brown's, License No. 77127. Would the parties
6 please approach and identify themselves for the
7 record, please?

8 MS. BROWN: Ayanna Brown.

9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I'm sorry, your
10 name, ma'am?

11 MS. BROWN: Ayanna Brown.

12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
13 Ms. Brown.

14 MR. ORTIZ: Stephen Ortiz on behalf of
15 District of Columbia.

16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
17 Mr. Ortiz. Are there any preliminary matters in
18 this case?

20 entered into an offer in compromise.

24 manager, the establishment shall pay \$350.00
25 within 30 days or its license shall be suspended

1 indefinitely until this fine is paid.

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Brown, it's
3 my understanding that there is an offer in
4 compromise, and the offer in compromise that
5 there's a fine of \$350.00 payable within 30 days.
6 If the fine is not paid within 30 days, the
7 license will be suspended until the fine has been
8 paid. Is this your understanding of the offer in
9 compromise?

10 MS. BROWN: Yes.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you aware
12 that by accepting an offer in compromise that
13 you're giving up your right to a hearing?

14 MS. BROWN: Yes.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you also
16 aware that by accepting an offer in compromise,
17 you're giving up the right to appeal this matter?

18 MS. BROWN: Yes.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: With that said,
20 I make a motion that the offer in compromise of a
21 fine of \$350.00 payable within 30 days be
22 accepted. If the fine is not paid within 30
23 days, the license will be suspended. Is there a
24 second?

25 MR. SHORT: Second.

1 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has
2 second the motion. All those in favor say aye.

3 (CHORUS OF AYES.)

4 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed?
5 The matter passed 6-0-0. Thank you, ma'am.
