**ORDER ON DISMISSAL OF PROTEST OF
THE MATRIX CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION**

The Application filed by Gordon Restaurant Group, LLC, for a new Retailer's Class CR License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on May 29, 2012, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).

On May 29, 2012, the Board dismissed the Protest of The Matrix Condominium Association, because a condominium association is not a citizens association. Therefore, The Matrix Condominium Association did not meet the standing requirements under D.C. Official Code § 25-601(3). The Matrix Condominium Association may file a Request for Reinstatement with the Board within ten (10) days from the date of this Order.
